1 Plaintiff's motion for an order finally approving the Stipulation of Settlement of Class and
2 PAGA Action Claims and Release of Claims ("Agreement") and Motion for Class Counsel Award
3 and Service Award duly came on for hearing on July 31, 2026, before the above-entitled Court. The
4 parties having settled this action and the Court having entered an Order Granting Motion for Final
5 Approval of Class Action and PAGA Settlement and good cause appearing therefor,

6 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDICATED and DECREED THAT:**

7 1. The certification of the Class is confirmed for the purposes of settlement. The Class
8 is defined as "all current and former non-exempt employees who worked for Defendant Shaxon
9 Industries, Inc. ("Defendant Shaxon"), Benjamin Wang, and Gilbert Wang (collectively
10 "Defendants") in California at any time between October 28, 2018, through November 7, 2024 (the
11 "Class Period")."

12 2. All persons who meet the foregoing definition are Settlement Class Members, except
13 for those individuals who filed a valid request for exclusion ("opt out") from the Class.

14 3. Except as set forth in the Agreement, the Order Granting Motion for Final Approval
15 of Class Action and PAGA Settlement and this Final Judgment, Plaintiff, and all members of the
16 Class, shall take nothing in the Action. Each party shall bear its own attorneys' fees and costs, except
17 as otherwise provided in the Agreement, the Order Granting Motion for Final Approval of Class
18 Action and PAGA Settlement and in this Final Judgment.

19 4. The Court shall retain jurisdiction to construe, interpret, implement, and enforce the
20 Agreement, to hear and resolve any contested challenge to a claim for settlement benefits, and to
21 supervise and adjudicate any dispute arising from or in connection with the distribution of settlement
22 benefits.

23 5. As of the date the Defendants fund the Gross Settlement Amount, Plaintiff and each
24 Class Member who has not validly opted out has released the "Released Parties" from the "Released
25 Class Claims" as set forth in the Agreement.

26 6. As used in paragraph 5 above, the quoted terms have the meanings set forth below:

27 a. The "Released Class Claims" are defined as all class claims alleged,
28 or reasonably could have been alleged based on the facts alleged in the operative complaint which

1 occurred during the Class Period, and expressly excluding all other claims, including claims for
2 vested benefits, wrongful termination, unemployment insurance, disability, social security, workers'
3 compensation, and class claims outside of the Class Period.

4 b. The “Released Parties” are defined as Defendants.

5 7. As of the date the Defendants fund the Gross Settlement Amount, Plaintiff and the
6 LWDA have released the Released Parties from the “Released PAGA Claims” for the “PAGA
7 Period” as set forth in the Agreement.

8 8. As used in paragraph 7 above, the quoted terms have the meanings set forth below:

9 (a) The “Released PAGA Claims” are defined as all PAGA claims alleged in the
10 operative complaint and Plaintiff’s PAGA notice to the LWDA which occurred during the PAGA
11 Period, and expressly excluding all other claims, including claims for vested benefits, wrongful
12 termination, unemployment insurance, disability, social security, workers' compensation, and
13 PAGA claims outside of the PAGA Period.

14 (b) The “PAGA Period” is defined as the period beginning August 11, 2021,
15 through November 7, 2024.

16 9. This Court hereby grants final approval and awards the following: (i) One Hundred
17 Twenty-Five Thousand Three Hundred Eleven Dollars and Fifty-Eight Cents (\$125,311.58) for the
18 Class Counsel Award comprised of Ninety-Nine Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$99,000.00) for
19 attorneys’ fees and litigation costs in the amount of Twenty-Six Thousand Eight Hundred Eleven
20 Dollars and Fifty-Eight Cents (\$26,811.58); (ii) the Service Award to Class Representative,
21 Christina Rodriguez, in the amount of Ten Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$10,000.00); (iii)
22 Settlement Administration Costs of Six Thousand Four Hundred Twenty-Five Dollars and Zero
23 Cents (\$6,425.00) to Apex Class Action, LLC; (iv) Eleven Thousand Two Hundred Fifty Dollars
24 and Zero Cents (\$11,250.00) (75% of the PAGA Payment) to the Labor and Workforce
25 Development Agency (“LWDA Payment”); and Three Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars and
26 Zero Cents (\$3,750.00) (25% of the PAGA Payment) allocated to the Aggrieved Employee
27 Payments.

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1 10. Plaintiff shall give notice of this Judgment to the Labor and Workforce Development
2 Agency within ten (10) days after entry of the Judgment or order pursuant to California Labor Code
3 section 2699(1)(3).

4 11. The Court sets a status conference on _____, at ____ a.m. in
5 Department CX101 to confirm the completion of the settlement process.
