Having considered Plaintiffs' Motion for Approval of PAGA Settlement, the papers, and declaration, the Court orders as follows:

The Private Attorneys General Act Settlement Agreement and Release is fully incorporated by reference as part of this Judgment
The Settlement of the PAGA claim in this matter is fair, adequate, and reasonable as

well as meaningful and consistent with the purposes of PAGA and, thus, is approved as follows:

The Gross Settlement Fund of \$10,000 is divided as follows:

1. Attorney's fees at \$1,000;
2. Administration expenses of \$3,500 to Simpluris, a third-party administrator retained for the mailing of notices and payments;
3. The remaining amount of \$5,500 in PAGA penalties to be distributed as set forth below:
 - a. 75% (or \$4,125.00) of the PAGA penalties will be distributed to the LWDA by Simpluris; and
 - b. 25% (or \$1,375.00) to the twenty (20) Aggrieved Employees paid pro rata based on the number of workweeks during the PAGA period and issued an IRS Form 1099.

Plaintiffs shall file and serve Notice of Entry of Judgment,
IT IS SO ORDERED. *including service on LWDA*

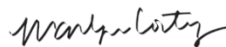
