1 **TO ALL PARTIES AND THEIR ATTORNEYS OF RECORD:**

2 **PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT** on July 28, 2025, at 8:30 a.m., the Motion for Preliminary
3 Approval of Class Action and PAGA Settlement filed by Plaintiff Gary Ogaz (“Plaintiff”), on
4 behalf of himself and a Settlement Class, and not opposed by Defendant Intelligrated Services,
5 LLC dba 415 Intelligrated Services, LLC (“Defendant”), came on for hearing in Department S26
6 of the San Bernardino County Superior Court, located at 247 West Third Street, San Bernardino,
7 CA 92415-0210.

8 After full consideration of the evidence, the pleadings and papers filed by the parties in
9 connection therewith, arguments of counsel and all other matters presented to the Court, and good
10 cause having been shown, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Plaintiff’s Motion for Preliminary
11 Approval of Class Action and PAGA Settlement is GRANTED based on the conditions below.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

13 1. This Order incorporates by reference the definitions in the Settlement Agreement
14 (“Agreement” or “Settlement Agreement”), and all terms defined therein shall have the same
15 meaning in this Order as set forth in the Settlement Agreement.

16 2. The Court recognizes that the parties stipulate and agree to certification of a class
17 for settlement purposes only. For settlement purposes only, the Court conditionally certifies the
18 following settlement class (the “Class Members” or “Settlement Class”): “all individuals who
19 worked for Defendant as non-exempt employees in California at any time between July 24, 2019,
20 and January 11, 2024.” The “Class Period” means the period from July 24, 2019 through January
21 11, 2024.

22 3. The Settlement also includes “PAGA Employees,” which is defined as “all individuals
23 who worked for Defendant as non-exempt employees in California at any time between November 16,
24 2019, through January 11, 2024.” “PAGA Period” means the period from November 16, 2019, through
25 January 11, 2024.

26 4. The Court finds, for settlement purposes only, the requirements of California Code
27 of Civil Procedure section 382 are satisfied. The term “Participating Class Member” means a
28 Class Member who has not requested exclusion from the Settlement.

1 5. Plaintiff is hereby appointed and designated, for all purposes, as the representative
2 of the class, and the following attorneys are hereby appointed and designated as counsel for
3 Plaintiff and the Class ("Class Counsel"):

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22 Class Counsel is authorized to act on behalf of Class Members with respect to all acts or
23 consents required by, or which may be given pursuant to, the Settlement, and such other acts
24 reasonably necessary to consummate the Settlement. Any Class Member may enter an appearance
25 through counsel of such Class Member's own choosing and at such Class Member's own expense.
26 Any Class Member who does not enter an appearance or appear on his or her own will be
27 represented by Class Counsel.

28 6. The Court hereby approves on a preliminary basis the Settlement Agreement as
appearing on its face to be fair, reasonable, and adequate and to have been the product of serious,
informed, and extensive negotiations among Plaintiff, Defendant, and their respective counsel.

7. A final approval hearing shall be held before this Court on 12/4/2025,
at 8:30am in Department S26 of the San Bernardino County Superior Court, located at 247 West
Third Street, San Bernardino, CA 92415-0210, to determine all necessary matters concerning the
Settlement, including: whether the proposed settlement of the Action on the terms and conditions

1 provided for in the Settlement Agreement is fair, adequate and reasonable and should be finally
2 approved by the Court; whether a Judgment, as provided in the Settlement, should be entered
3 herein; whether the plan of allocation contained in the Settlement Agreement should be approved
4 as fair, adequate and reasonable to the Class Members; and to finally approve Class Counsels'
5 Fees and Costs Award, the Class Representative Enhancement Payments, the PAGA payment to
6 the LWDA and the settlement administration expenses. The Final Approval hearing may be
7 continued without further notice.

8 8. The Parties shall file a Motion for Final Approval on or before sixteen (16) court
9 days prior to the hearing.

10 9. The Court hereby appoints Phoenix Class Action Administrators as Settlement
11 Administrator and hereby directs the Settlement Administrator to mail or cause to be mailed to
12 Class Members (including the Aggrieved Employees) the Notice by first class mail within fourteen
13 (14) calendar days after the receipt of the Class Data from Defendant using the procedures set forth
14 in the Settlement Agreement. Class Members who do not opt out of the non-PAGA portion of the
15 settlement will become Participating Class Members and will automatically receive their
16 Individual Settlement Payment.

17 10. The Court hereby approves, as to form and content, the Notice of Class Action
18 Settlement and Hearing Date for Final Court Approval attached as Exhibit 3 to the Declaration of
19 Devin Rauchwerger filed concurrently herewith. The Court finds that the distribution of the Notice
20 of Class Action Settlement is substantially in the manner and form set forth in the Settlement
21 Agreement and this Order meets the requirements of due process, is the best notice practicable
22 under the circumstances, and shall constitute due and sufficient notice to all persons entitled
23 thereto.

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1 11. The Court reserves the right to adjourn or continue the date of the final approval
2 and all dates provided for in the Settlement Agreement without further notice and retains
3 jurisdiction to consider all further applications arising out of or connected with the proposed
4 Settlement.
