APPROVAL OF PAGA SETTLEMENT**

23 The matter having come regularly for hearing on September 12, 2024 in Dept. CX104 of
24 the above-entitled Court and having considered the records and files in this action, and the oral
25 and documentary evidence presented at hearing on Plaintiff's Motion, along with the Private
26 Attorneys General Act Settlement Agreement and Release (the "Settlement Agreement")
27 submitted therewith, and good cause appearing, the Court hereby GRANTS Plaintiff's Motion
28 for Approval of PAGA Settlement ("Motion"), subject to the following findings and orders:

- 1 a) Pursuant to Labor Code § 2699(1)(2), the Court has reviewed the Settlement
2 Agreement and finds the proposed settlement of PAGA claims to be fair and
3 reasonable. All defined terms contained herein shall have the same meanings as
4 set forth in the Settlement Agreement executed by the Parties and filed with this
5 Court.
- 6 b) The Court approves the Settlement Agreement and confirms the release and
7 waiver of claims provided therein. Upon entry of this Order, the Parties shall
8 effectuate and act in accordance with all terms of the Settlement Agreement.
- 9 c) Pursuant to the terms of the Settlement Agreement, the Court approves the PAGA
10 Payment in the amount of \$140,000.00. 75% of the PAGA Payment will be
11 allocated and paid to the California Labor and Workforce Development Agency
12 (\$47,887.50). 25% of the PAGA Payment will be allocated and distributed
13 amongst the 33 alleged aggrieved employees (\$15,962.50).
- 14 d) The PAGA action is hereby DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE in its entirety.
15 Pursuant to C.C.P. §664.6, this Court shall have and retain continuing jurisdiction
16 over this action to enforce the terms of the parties' agreement. Other than as
17 expressly provided in the Settlement Agreement, both Parties shall bear their own
18 costs and fees. The dismissal does not extend to or otherwise affect the ability of
19 an aggrieved employee to bring individual, non-representative claims against the
20 defendant for alleged violations of the Labor Code.
- 21 e) Pursuant to Labor Code § 2699(1)(3), Plaintiff shall submit a copy of this Order
22 to the LWDA within 10 days of entry of this Order.
- 23 f) The date for the Final Accounting hearing is scheduled for
24 _____, 2024 and the deadline for filing a report concerning the
25 amount of money distributed and/or uncashed is _____,
26 2024.
