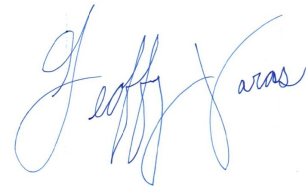

1 On July 8, 2024, the Court entered the Order Granting Preliminary Approval of Class
2 Action Settlement (“Preliminary Approval Order”), thereby preliminarily approving the settlement
3 of the above-entitled action (“Action”) in accordance with the Joint Stipulation of Class Action
4 and PAGA Settlement (“Settlement,” “Agreement,” or “Settlement Agreement”) entered into
5 between Plaintiff and Defendant Northern California Retina Vitreous Associates Medical Group,
6 Inc. (“Defendant”), which, together with the exhibits annexed thereto set forth the terms and
7 conditions for settlement of the Action.

8 On December 26, 2024, the Court entered the Final Approval Order and Judgment (“Final
9 Approval Order”), thereby granting final approval of the settlement of the Action.

10 On July 24, 2025, the Final Accounting Report, including the July 23, 2025 Declaration of
11 Lisa Pavlik Regarding Distribution (“Administrator’s Declaration”) was submitted for filing in the
12 Action. The Administrator’s Declaration reflects the following (among other things):

- 13 • On April 3, 2025, Simpluris mailed Settlement Checks to one hundred fifty-two
14 (152) Settlement Class Members via USPS.
- 15 • As of this date [July 23, 2025], all payments have been made for Attorneys’ Fees
16 and Costs, Plaintiff’s Enhancement Payment, Settlement Administration Costs,
17 Employer Share of Taxes and LWDA PAGA Payment.
- 18 • As of this date [July 23, 2025], there are twenty-eight (28) uncashed checks. The
19 remaining account balance is approximately \$25,393.64.
- 20 • The check cashing period expires on September 30, 2025, which is 180 days from
21 the issuance date of April 3, 2025.
- 22 • Settlement checks which are not negotiated within 180 calendar days after the date
23 they are mailed shall be void. Such monies and any other funds not disbursed or
24 negotiated as part of the Settlement shall be sent to Legal Aid at Work [after the
25 Court’s amended judgment].

26 On October 20, 2025, the Supplemental Final Accounting Report, including the
27 Supplemental Declaration of Lisa Pavlik Regarding Disbursement (“Administrator’s
28 Supplemental Declaration”) was submitted for filing in the Action. The Administrator’s

Supplemental Declaration indicates that the check cashing period has now expired and that there are twenty-five (25) uncashed checks remaining, with a total account balance of \$14,035.35. It also indicates that, after Court approval, Simpluris will send the \$14,035.35 uncashed funds to Legal Aid at Work, which is the court-approved cy pres recipient.

Having reviewed the Administrator's Declaration and Supplemental Declaration, and good cause appearing,

THE COURT HEREBY ORDERS, ADJUDGES, AND DECREES AS FOLLOWS:

1. The distribution of the funds associated with the uncashed settlement checks to Legal Aid at Work, in the amount of \$14,035.35, is approved.

2. After entry of this Amended Judgment, pursuant to California Code of Civil Procedure, Plaintiff shall submit the Amended Judgment to the Judicial Council.
