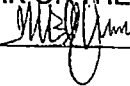

1. PLAINTIFF MATTHEW CORNELL's Motion for Approval of PAGA Settlement is
GRANTED.

2. Good cause appearing and notice having been provided to LWDA, the court approves the
parties' settlement agreement, including the settlement of the PAGA claims. (See Lab. Code, 2699(s).)

3. The court finds the attorney's fees award is, at best, at the very margin of reasonable and
the administrator's fees are unusually high.

4. But LWDA, the agency charged with enforcement of the labor laws at issue here and the
party who would most benefit from a reduced fee award, received notice and has not objected.

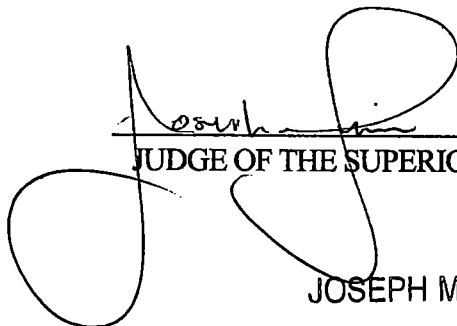
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5. Thus, the court approves the settlement, notwithstanding these concerns.

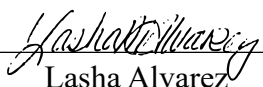
