DECLARATION OF JESSA NALUZ

I, Jessa Naluz, hereby declare as follows:

1. I am over 18 years of age and a resident of California. I am one of the named plaintiffs in the above-captioned case. I have personal knowledge of the facts and statements set forth in this declaration, and if called upon to testify, I could and would competently testify thereto.

2. I was employed by C & J Clark Retail, Inc. ("C & J Clark") as an hourly-paid Team Lead from approximately April 2018 to approximately March 2020. I decided to seek legal advice about my work experiences with C & J Clark and about pursuing my grievances. I contacted Lawyers *for* Justice, PC and spoke with attorneys there. I wanted to do whatever I could to make sure that C & J Clark was held accountable for not paying its employees for all hours worked and non-compliant meal and rest breaks. I consulted with the attorneys at Lawyers *for* Justice, PC for 3 hours discussing my situation, representative actions under the Private Attorneys General Act ("PAGA") in general, and what it meant to be a named plaintiff and PAGA representative.

3. I have spent over 5 hours communicating with my attorneys regarding the case and fulfilling my responsibilities as a class and PAGA representative, which included gathering documents concerning my employment with C & J Clark, reviewing documents with my attorneys and answering their questions, providing guidance regarding the duties of non-exempt employees, and helping develop a strategy as to what documents and information to obtain from C & J Clark. I routinely checked in with my attorneys and their staff to make sure they had all of my most current information and any additional information that I had obtained.

4. I was available to answer any questions my attorneys had, and available to speak and meet with my attorneys whenever they needed me. I responded to them as quickly as possible and gave them as much information and

1 identified as many documents as I could. I spent at least 4 additional hours
2 working with my attorneys, speaking with my attorneys about the case, identifying
3 potential witnesses, providing my attorneys with documents and information
4 concerning the case, and also describing policies, practices, and procedures of C &
5 J Clark.

6 5. As far as the settlement is concerned, I was available to review
7 documents and answer any questions my attorneys had. I spent about 1.5 hours
8 reviewing the settlement documents, asking questions, and discussing the potential
9 settlement with my attorneys before signing the settlement agreement.

10 6. I believe that I have done everything that my attorneys have asked of
11 me and have tried, to the best of my ability, to represent the class and seek relief
12 for the aggrieved employees and the State of California. I think my efforts have
13 helped to obtain the result in this case, and as a class and PAGA representative, I
14 respectfully request that the Court award me a Class Representative Enhancement
15 Payment in the amount of \$7,500.00 for my active participation in this case.
16 Taking into consideration the time that I have dedicated to this case, I believe that
17 this amount is reasonable.

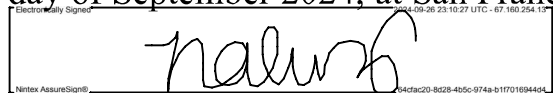
18 7. I am not related to anyone associated with Lawyers *for* Justice, PC.
