On January 20, 2026, this court entered an order granting final approval of the settlement of this class and PAGA action and awarding attorney's fees, costs, and service awards. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED THAT:

1. Judgment is hereby entered in accordance with the terms of this court's final approval order.

2. The Settlement Classes are defined as follows:

- The “Class” is defined as: all current and former employees of Defendant Altum who performed work for Defendants as non-exempt, hourly-paid employees in California at any time during the Class Period (from July 28, 2017, through December 8, 2022). (SA, §§ 1.5, 1.7.)
- “PAGA Aggrieved Employees” are defined as: all current and former employees of Defendant Altum on whose behalf Plaintiff Ortiz sought civil penalties under the Labor Code Private Attorneys General Act of 2024 (Cal. Lab. Code §§ 2698, et seq., “PAGA”) who worked for Defendant Altum as non-exempt, hourly paid employees at any time during the PAGA Period (from September 14, 2020 through December 8, 2022). (SA, §§ 1.2, 1.28.)

3. No class members objected, opted out or requested exclusion.

4. Pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure section 664.6, and Rule 3.769(h) of the California Rules of Court and without impacting the finality of this judgment-the court retains jurisdiction over plaintiffs, all members of the Settlement Classes, and defendants for the purpose of supervising the implementation, enforcement, construction, administration, and interpretation of the Settlement Agreement, Final Approval Order, and judgment thereon.

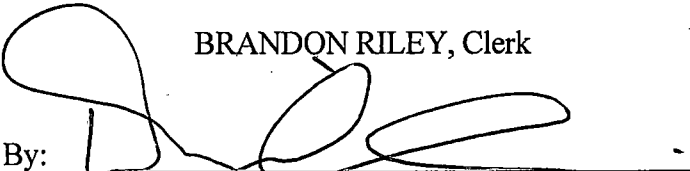
