TO ALL PARTIES AND THEIR ATTORNEYS OF RECORD:

The Court has entered an Order granting final approval of the Parties' Settlement (the "Final Approval Order"). The Court now has before it a [Proposed] Judgment.

The Court, having entered a Final Approval Order in this Action, and good cause appearing,
HEREBY ADJUDGES AND DECREES AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Court, for purposes of this Judgment, refers to all terms and definitions as set forth in the Settlement.

2. The Court enters Judgment as follows: Plaintiff, Class Counsel, Aggrieved Employees, the California Labor and Workforce Development Agency, and the Settlement Administrator shall take nothing from Defendant except as expressly set forth in the Final Approval Order and according to the terms of the Settlement.

3. The Parties shall bear their own respective attorneys' fees and costs, except as otherwise provided for in the Settlement and approved by the Court.

Notwithstanding the finality of this Judgment, pursuant to California Code of Civil Procedure section 664.6, the Court shall retain jurisdiction over the Parties, Action, and the Settlement solely for purposes of (i) enforcing the Settlement and/or Judgment, (ii) addressing settlement administration matters, and (iii) addressing such post-Judgment matters as are permitted by law.
