1 Agreement ¶ 8, as set forth in the Settlement Agreement.

2 6. The Court approves a PAGA Counsel Fees Payment of \$45,000, allocated as follows:
3 \$19,125 to the Bokhour Law Group, P.C., \$19,125 to Falakassa Law, P.C., and \$6,750 to James
4 Hawkins, APLC., to be paid from the Gross Settlement Amount as full compensation for all
5 attorneys' fees incurred or to be incurred in connection with the Action, the arbitration, and the
6 implementation of the Settlement.

7 7. The Court approves a PAGA Counsel Litigation Expenses Payment of \$15,104.87
8 to Bokhour Law Group, P.C. and \$3,063.36 to James Hawkins, APLC, to be paid from the Gross
9 Settlement Amount as full reimbursement of actual, out-of-pocket litigation costs reasonably
10 incurred in the prosecution and resolution of the Action.

11 8. The Court approves Service Awards in the amount of \$4,500 to each of the two
12 named Plaintiffs for their time, effort, and services in representing the interests of the State of
13 California and Aggrieved Employees. This amount shall be paid from the Gross Settlement Amount.

14 9. The Court appoints ILYM Group, Inc. as the Settlement Administrator and approves
15 an Administration Expenses Payment of \$4,350.00, to be paid from the Gross Settlement Amount,
16 as reasonable and necessary to administer the Settlement.

17 10. The remaining PAGA Penalties, totaling \$103,481.77, shall be allocated as follows:
18 75% (\$77,611.33) to the LWDA and 25% (\$25,870.44) to the Aggrieved Employees, to be
19 distributed pro rata based on the number of PAGA Pay Periods worked during the PAGA Period, as
20 set forth in the Settlement Agreement.

21 11. Upon Defendant's full funding of the Gross Settlement Amount, the releases set forth
22 in the Settlement Agreement shall become effective and binding on the Parties. The Court confirms
23 the following:

24 Pursuant to Section 5.2 of the Settlement Agreement, the LWDA, the State of California,
25 and all Aggrieved Employees shall be deemed to release, on behalf of themselves and their
26 respective former and present representatives, agents, attorneys, heirs, administrators,
27 successors, and assigns, the Released Parties from all claims for PAGA Penalties that were
28 alleged or reasonably could have been alleged, based on the facts stated in the Operative

Complaint and the PAGA Notices.

12. Neither this Order, the Judgment, nor the Settlement Agreement shall be construed as an admission or concession of liability or wrongdoing by Defendant or the Released Parties. The Settlement is entered into solely for the purpose of compromise and resolution. This Order and Judgment shall not be used or admissible in any other proceeding, except as necessary to enforce its terms or to support defenses such as *res judicata* or release.

13. The Court reserves continuing jurisdiction over the implementation, enforcement, interpretation, and administration of the Settlement Agreement, this Order, and the Judgment pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure § 664.6.

14. Within ten (10) days of entry of this Order and Judgment, Plaintiffs shall submit a copy to the LWDA, as required by Labor Code § 2699(1)(3). Within seven (7) days thereafter, PAGA Counsel shall file a declaration confirming compliance with that requirement.

15. The Court hereby enters final judgment in this Action pursuant to the terms of the Settlement Agreement and this Order.

IT IS SO ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED.
