2 Class Member Scott Schuster's ("Intervenor") application for an Order granting him leave
3 pursuant to Section 387 of the Code of Civil Procedure to file a Complaint in Intervention and leave
4 to intervene in this action in order to represent the State of California and a subclass of employees
5 who are aggrieved under the Private Attorneys General Act, Labor Code Section 2698 et seq.
6 ("PAGA") and the classes of employees defined in the Complaint in Intervention, came for hearing
