7 eighty (180) calendar days from the date the checks were issued.

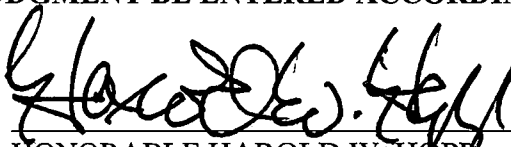
8 Pursuant to the Settlement Agreement, the Administrator transmitted the uncashed
