1 The Court has reviewed and considered the Unopposed Motion for Approval of Private
2 Attorneys General Act Representative Action Settlement ("Motion") filed by Plaintiff Antonia
3 Rodriguez de Gomez ("Plaintiff"), on behalf of herself and all other aggrieved employees. Pursuant
4 to Labor Code Section 2699, subdivision (1)(2), based on Plaintiff's Motion, all filings related to the
5 Unopposed Motion, all other papers filed in this action, arguments of counsel, and good cause
6 appearing therefor,

7 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED:**

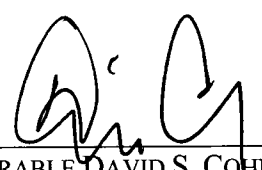
8 The Court hereby GRANTS the unopposed Motion and approves the settlement of claims
9 under the California Private Attorneys General Act of 2004, California Labor Code § 2698 et seq.
10 ("PAGA") reached by Plaintiff and Defendant Chancellor Health Care of California I, Inc.
11 ("Defendant" and together with Plaintiff, the "Parties"). The Court hereby enters final judgment in
12 accordance with the terms of the Parties' Settlement Agreement in the gross settlement amount of
13 \$142,032.00. Of this amount, \$47,344 is awarded as attorneys' fees paid to Plaintiff's counsel;
14 \$2,448.19 is awarded as litigation costs paid to Plaintiff's counsel; \$2,500 is awarded to Plaintiff as
15 a service award and general release payment; and \$8,250.00 is awarded as administrative costs paid
16 to the settlement administrator, CPT Group, Inc. The net remainder (\$81,489.81) will be paid 75% to
17 the LWDA (\$61,117.36) and 25% to the PAGA aggrieved employees (\$20,372.45) in accordance
18 with Labor Code § 2699, subdivision (i).

19 This Judgment incorporates by reference the terms in the Settlement Agreement and all terms
20 defined therein shall have the same meaning as set forth in the Settlement Agreement.

21 This Judgment intended to be a final disposition in its entirety of the above captioned action.
22 Without affecting the finality of this judgment in any way, the Court retains jurisdiction of all matters
23 relating to the interpretation, administration, implementation, effectuation, and enforcement of the
24 Settlement pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure Section 664.6.

25 **IT IS SO ORDERED AND ADJUDGED.**
