1 **JUDGMENT**

2 Pursuant to the Order Granting the Motion for Final Approval of Class Action Settlement,
3 Attorneys' Fees, Costs, and Enhancement Awards, it is hereby **ORDERED, ADJUGED, AND**
4 **DECREED** as follows:

5 1. Judgment in this matter is entered in accordance with, and incorporates by reference the
6 findings of, the Court's Order Granting the Motion for Final Approval of Class Action Settlement,
7 Attorneys' Fees, Costs, and Enhancement Awards ("Order Granting Final Approval") and the Joint
8 Stipulation and Settlement of Class Action ("Settlement Agreement"). Judgment is entered against
9 Defendant Amazon Processing, LLC in favor of Plaintiffs Sherrie Ward, Kemit Johnson, Settling
10 Parties, PAGA Members, and Class Counsel Justice Law Corporation and Law Offices of Jong Yun
11 Kim. Unless otherwise provided herein, all capitalized terms used herein shall have the same meaning
12 as defined in the Settlement Agreement.

13 2. As provided by the Order Granting Final Approval, all Class Members who did not
14 timely and properly opt-out from the Settlement are banned from pursuing, or seeking to reopen, any
15 of the Released Claims, as defined in the Settlement Agreement. Consistent with the definitions
16 provided in the Settlement Agreement, the Settlement Class consists of: All persons who provided
17 services to Defendant Amazon Processing, LLC as an independent contractor in California during the
18 period April 15, 2011 through September 5, 2016.

19 3. Without affecting the finality of the Judgment, the Court shall retain exclusive
20 jurisdiction and continuing jurisdiction over the above-captioned action and the parties, including all
21 Class Members, for purposes of enforcing the terms of the Judgment entered herein pursuant to
22 California Code of Civil Procedure section 664.6 and California Rules of Court Rule 3.769(h).

23 4. This document shall constitute a judgment (and separate document constituting said
24 judgment) for purposes of California Rules of Court Rule 3.769(h).

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1 5. Notice of entry of this Judgment shall be given to Class Members by posting on the
2 Court's website for a period of at least thirty (30) days. It shall not be necessary to send notice of the
3 entry of this Judgment to individual Class Members. The time for any appeal shall run from the
4 Court's entry of this Judgment.

5 **IT IS SO ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED.**

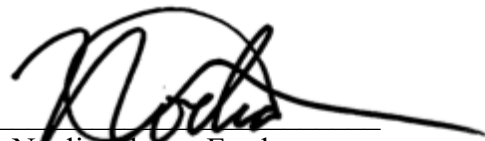
