[PROPOSED] AMENDED JUDGMENT

1. On August 8, 2023, this Court entered an Order Granting Plaintiff Karolina Torrez's Motion for Final Approval of Class Action and PAGA Settlement and a Judgment.

2. The Settlement Administrator has reported that 1,077 settlement checks totaling \$64,763.29 remained uncashed after the January 28, 2025 check cashing deadline.

3. Pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure § 384(b), the Court hereby AMENDS the Judgment entered on August 8, 2023 as follows:

4. The Court hereby directs the Settlement Administrator, ILYM Group, Inc., to pay itself \$64,763.29 for fees and costs related to the second, third, and fourth distributions.

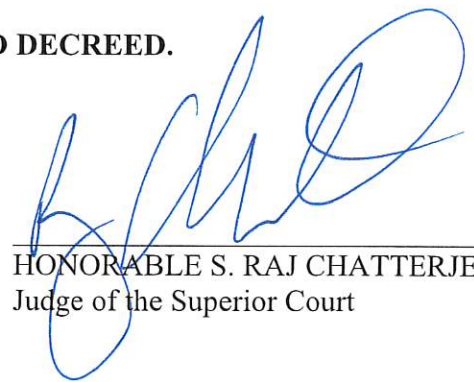
5. The Court hereby directs the Settlement Administrator to distribute the 10% (\$1,250,000.00) of attorney's fees that has been withheld.

6. Within ten (10) calendar days after the Court's entry of judgment, the Settlement Administrator shall post notice of this Amended Judgment on the website (www.torrezvdeltaco.com) the Settlement Administrator established for purposes of settlement administration.

7. Plaintiff shall submit a copy of this Amended Judgment to the Labor and Workforce Development Agency within ten (10) calendar days of the Court's entry of this Amended Judgment and shall file a proof of service with the Court.
