1 **[PROPOSED] ORDER**

2 This matter came on for hearing on July 11, 2024 at 8:30 a.m. in Department 1 of the
3 above-entitled Court, the Honorable David Mathias presiding. Based on the pleadings on
4 record, all papers submitted in connection with Plaintiff's Notice of Motion and Motion to
5 Approve PAGA Settlement (the "Motion"), and for good cause appearing, Plaintiff's Motion is
6 GRANTED.

7 The Court approves the PAGA Settlement Agreement ("Settlement") entered into by
8 Plaintiff Abraham Rodriguez ("Plaintiff") and Defendant Elkhorn Dairy, LLC ("Defendant,"
9 and together with Plaintiff, the "Parties"), which is attached to the Declaration of Justin F.
10 Marquez in Support of Plaintiff's Motion to Approve PAGA Settlement as Exhibit B, and hereby
11 ORDERS as follows:

12 1. Defendant shall pay the Gross Settlement Amount of \$90,000.00 according to the
13 terms of the Settlement.

14 2. The Net Settlement Amount means the Gross Settlement Amount minus the
15 following: (a) \$30,000 allocated to Attorneys' Fees; (b) \$13,569.51 allocated to litigation costs;
16 (c) \$6,500.00 allocated to Settlement Administrator Costs; and (d) \$5,000.00 allocated to Plaintiff
17 as a Service Award.

18 (a) The Court approves payment to Plaintiff's counsel, Wilshire Law Firm, of
19 Attorneys' Fees in the amount of Thirty Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents
20 (\$30,000.00), to be paid from the Gross Settlement Amount.

21 (b) The Court approves payment to Plaintiff's counsel, Wilshire Law Firm, of
22 litigation costs in the amount of \$13,569.51 to be paid from the Gross
23 Settlement Amount.

24 (c) The Court approves payment to the Settlement Administrator, Apex Class
25 Action, LLC, for its reasonable costs and fees to administer the Settlement,
26 not to exceed Eight Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$6,500.00), to be paid
27 from the Gross Settlement Amount.

28 (d) The Court approves Five Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$5,000.00) to

be paid to Plaintiff as a Service Payment for his efforts as a named plaintiff and representative for other PAGA Employees and the State of California, to be paid from the Gross Settlement Amount.

3. Of the Net Settlement Amount, 75% is allocated to the California Labor and Workforce Development Agency (“LWDA”); and 25% is allocated to the Individual PAGA Payments.

4. The “PAGA Period” is defined as the period from June 7, 2021 through the date of approval of the settlement.

5. The “PAGA Employees” or “Aggrieved Employees” are defined as a person employed by Defendant Elkhorn Dairy, LLC in California and classified as hourly-paid, non-exempt workers who worked for Defendant Elkhorn Dairy, LLC during the PAGA Period. The PAGA Employees are bound by the release outlined in Paragraph 5.2 of the Settlement Agreement.

6. “Effective Date” means the date by when both of the following have occurred: (a) the Court enters a Judgment on its Order Approving the PAGA Settlement; and (b) the Judgment is final.

7. The Court directs Defendant to fully fund the Gross Settlement Amount by transmitting the funds to the Settlement Administrator within 30 days of the Effective Date.

8. The amount of each Aggrieved Employee’s Individual PAGA Payment will be calculated as follows: (a) the Settlement Administrator will divide the amount of the Aggrieved Employees’ share of PAGA Penalties by the total number of PAGA Period Pay Periods worked by all Aggrieved Employees during the PAGA Period; and (b) the Settlement Administrator will multiply the result in Part (a) by each Aggrieved Employee’s PAGA Period Pay Periods.

9. The Court directs the Parties and the Settlement Administrator to carry out the terms of the Settlement.

10. Under California Code of Civil Procedure section 664.6, the Court retains jurisdiction over the Parties to enforce the Settlement until performance in full of the Settlement’s terms.

11. Plaintiff’s counsel shall submit a copy of this Order to the LWDA.

1 12. The above-referenced action and all claims asserted by Plaintiff individually and in
2 a representative capacity are hereby dismissed with prejudice.

3 13. Plaintiff shall give notice.
