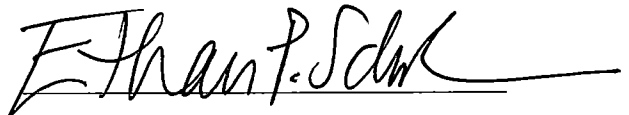
3 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that:
