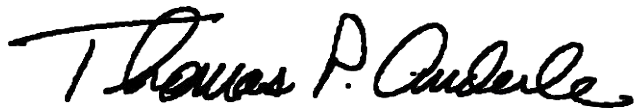
**[PROPOSED ORDER] FOR DISMISSAL
OF CLASS CLAIMS AND
REPRESENTATIVE PAGA CLAIMS
WITHOUT PREJUDICE**

1 Based on Plaintiff Ashley Whitaker's Request for Dismissal and the Declaration of Emma
2 Geesaman in support thereof, and good cause appearing therefore, the Court hereby approves the
3 dismissal of Plaintiff's individual claims with prejudice and orders the above-titled action
4 dismissed without prejudice as to the claims of the unnamed putative class members and
5 Aggrieved Employees and each party to bear their own costs and fees.

6 The Court finds that dismissal without notice will not prejudice the unnamed putative class
7 members and therefore, pursuant to California Rule of Court 3.770(c), the action may be
8 dismissed without notice to the unnamed putative class members.
