This matter came on for hearing on February 13, 2026 at 9:00 a.m. in Department 23 of the above-entitled Court, the Honorable Jill H. Talley presiding. Based on the pleadings on record, all papers submitted in connection with Plaintiffs' Notice of Motion and Motion to Approve PAGA Settlement (the "Motion"), and for good cause appearing, Plaintiffs' Motion is GRANTED.

The Court approves the PAGA Settlement Agreement ("Settlement") entered into by plaintiffs Patricia Stinson and Malia Casarez ("Plaintiffs") and defendant St. Anton Multifamily Inc. ("Defendant," and collectively with Plaintiffs, the "Parties"), and hereby ORDERS as follows:

1. Defendant shall pay the Gross Settlement Amount of \$125,000.00 according to the terms of the Settlement.

2. The Net Settlement Amount means the Gross Settlement Amount minus the following: (a) \$41,666.67 allocated to Attorneys' Fees; (b) \$19,755.05 allocated to litigation costs; (c) \$4,500.00 allocated to Settlement Administrator Costs; and (d) \$7,500.00 allocated to each Plaintiff (\$15,000.00 total) as a PAGA Representative Award.

(a) The Court approves payment to Plaintiffs' counsel, Wilshire Law Firm, PLC, of Attorneys' Fees in the amount of Forty-One Thousand Six Hundred Sixty-Six Dollars and Sixty-Seven Cents (\$41,666.67), to be paid from the Gross Settlement Amount.

(b) The Court approves payment to Plaintiffs' counsel, Wilshire Law Firm, PLC, of litigation costs in the amount of Nineteen Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty-Five Dollars and Five Cents (\$19,755.05), to be paid from the Gross Settlement Amount.

(c) The Court approves payment to the Settlement Administrator, Phoenix Settlement Administrators ("Phoenix"), for its reasonable costs and fees to administer the Settlement, not to exceed Four Thousand Five Hundred

Dollars and Zero Cents (\$4,500.00), to be paid from the Gross Settlement Amount.

(d) The Court approves Seven Thousand Five Hundred Dollars and Zero Cents (\$7,500.00) to be paid to each Plaintiff (Fifteen Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$15,000.00) total) as a PAGA Representative Award for their efforts as named plaintiffs and representatives for other PAGA Employees and the State of California, to be paid from the Gross Settlement Amount.

3. Accordingly, the Net Settlement Amount equals \$44,078.28.

4. Of the Net Settlement Amount, 75%, or \$33,058.71, is allocated to the California Labor & Workforce Development Agency (“LWDA”) and 25%, or \$11,019.57, is allocated to the aggrieved employees.

5. The “PAGA Period” is defined as the period from March 6, 2023 to December 5, 2024.

6. The “Aggrieved Employee” means a person employed by Defendant in California and classified as an hourly-paid or non-exempt employee who worked for Defendant during the PAGA Period. The Aggrieved Employees are bound by the release outlined in Paragraph 5.2 of the Settlement Agreement.

7. “Effective Date” means the date by when both of the following have occurred: (a) the Court enters a Judgment on the Approval Order and (b) the Judgment is final. The Judgment is final as of the latest of the following occurrences: (a) the day the Court enters Judgment assuming no appeal is filed; or (b) if a timely appeal is filed, the date of final resolution of that appeal (including any requests for rehearing and/or petitions for writs of certiorari) resulting in final judicial approval of the Settlement.

8. The Court directs Defendant to fully fund the Gross Settlement Amount by transmitting the funds to the Settlement Administrator no later than 45 days after the Effective Date.

9. The Settlement Administrator will calculate each Individual PAGA Payment as follows: (a) dividing the amount of the Aggrieved Employees’ 25% share of PAGA Penalties by

1 the total number of PAGA Period Pay Periods worked by all Aggrieved Employees during the
2 PAGA Period; and (b) multiplying the result in Part A by each Aggrieved Employee's PAGA
3 Period Pay Periods.

4 10. The Court directs the Parties and the Settlement Administrator to carry out the terms
5 of the Settlement.

6 11. Under California Code of Civil Procedure section 664.6, the Court retains
7 jurisdiction over the Parties to enforce the Settlement until performance in full of the Settlement's
8 terms.

9 12. Upon completion of administration of the Settlement, the Settlement Administrator
10 will provide written certification of such completion to the Court, which shall be filed with the
11 Court at least 15 days prior to the settlement compliance hearing set for **December 18, 2026 at**
12 **10:30 a.m.** If the Court is satisfied that the settlement funds have been fully distributed, no
13 appearance will be required at the settlement compliance hearing.

14 13. Plaintiffs' counsel shall submit a copy of this Order to the LWDA within seven (7)
15 days of the entry of the Order.

16 14. The above-referenced action and all claims asserted by Plaintiffs individually and
17 in a representative capacity are hereby dismissed with prejudice.

18 15. Plaintiffs shall give notice.
