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1 TO THE HONORABLE COURT:

2 Plaintiffs Maria Ventura and Claudia Gonzalez (“Plaintiffs”) submit the following
3 supplemental brief in response to the Court’s tentative ruling, published on January 27, 2026,
4 regarding Plaintiffs’ Motion for Preliminary Approval of Class Action Settlement. The tentative
5 ruling directed the parties to address the following two issues.

6 **1. Payment Plan**

7 The Court ordered the parties to submit a declaration from Defendant Braun Linen
8 Service, Inc. (“Braun Linen”) evidencing its financial condition and the need for an installment
9 plan to fund the settlement. Filed concurrently herewith is the Declaration of Scott Cornwell,
10 Braun Linen’s President, which explains the need for an installment plan in light of Braun Linen’s
11 financial condition.

12 **2. Escalator Clause/Class Period**

13 The Court ordered the parties to review and verify the workweek total and confirm the
14 end date for the Class/PAGA Period.

15 Pursuant to the terms of the Settlement Agreement, the Class Period and PAGA Period
16 end on the earlier of September 6, 2025 or the date of preliminary approval. The escalator clause
17 is triggered if the number of workweeks during the Class Period exceeds 10% greater than
18 45,235 workweeks.

19 Braun Linen’s counsel has confirmed to Plaintiffs’ counsel that, based on Braun Linen’s
20 review of its records, the escalator clause has not been triggered. Specifically, the number of
21 workweeks from September 9, 2020 through September 6, 2025, does not exceed 10% greater
22 than 45,234 workweeks.

23 Therefore, the Class Period will end on September 6, 2025, and no revision to the
24 Settlement Agreement or to the Class Notice is needed.
