The Motion of Plaintiff Cinthia Ramirez ("Plaintiff") to Approve the Settlement Agreement with Defendants DTLA Insurance Brokers, LLC, a California limited liability company, and David Garcia, an individual, came before this Court on . 2024, at 8:30 a.m., in Department S23 of the above-entitled Court.

Having duly reviewed and fully considered the evidence presented, including all papers, pleadings, and oral argument, and support and opposition thereto, and good cause appearing, this Court rules as follows:

IT IS HEREBY Ordered that the Motion for Approval of Settlement Agreement between Plaintiff and Defendants is GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, pursuant to the agreement of the parties, the Court shall retain jurisdiction over them, pursuant to *Code of Civil Procedure* §664.6, to enforce the terms of the Settlement Agreement, and to enter Judgment in the amount of \$50,000, less any payments made by Defendants, upon default under the Settlement Agreement.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the claims settled pursuant to this Agreement are Plaintiff's individual and Plaintiff individual PAGA claims. The PAGA claims that pertain to any other aggrieved past or current employee (other than Plaintiff) shall be dismissed *without prejudice*.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
