15 ORDER AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT AND, WITHOUT AFFECTING THE
16 FINALITY OF THIS MATTER, RETAINS EXCLUSIVE AND CONTINUING
17 JURISDICTION TO ENFORCE THIS ORDER, THE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT,
