**AMENDED ~~PROPOSED~~ JUDGMENT**

**AMENDED JUDGMENT**

1 The Motion for Final Approval of Class Action Settlement came before this Court for  
2 hearing on July 8, 2024, at 8:30 a.m., in Department 1 of the above-captioned Court, at which  
3 time the Court granted final approval.

4 On May 2, 2025, Plaintiffs submitted the Supplemental Declaration Of Makenna Snow  
5 dated April 30, 2025, providing a final report on the settlement administration process.

6 The Court, having granted final approval to the Settlement Agreement, and having  
7 received the Supplemental Declaration Of Makenna Snow, HEREBY ORDERS THAT FINAL  
8 JUDGMENT BE ENTERED AS FOLLOWS:

9 1. The Settlement Agreement shall be enforced according to its terms.

10 2. The Court has certified a Settlement Class, as that term is defined in and by the  
11 terms of the Settlement Agreement as all non-exempt employees who worked at the Leef  
12 Industries dispensary located at 3700 E. Vista Chino, Palm Springs, CA 92262 at any time during  
13 the Class Period (of April 5, 2018 through April 26, 2023). The Court deems this definition  
14 sufficient for purposes of California Rule of Court 3.765(a).

15 3. The Court finds there are a total of 28 participating Class Members.

16 4. A total of \$22,500.00 was paid to the California Labor and Workforce  
17 Development Agency as its share of the settlement of civil penalties.

18 5. A total of \$3,450.00 was paid to ILYM Group, Inc. for its fees and expenses in  
19 administering the Settlement.

20 6. A total of \$10,000.00 for the Enhancement Award was paid to Devon M. Purdy.

21 7. A total of \$108,333.33 was paid to Class Counsel for attorneys' fees and  
22 \$15,640.85 was paid to Class Counsel for litigation costs.

23 8. The total settlement amount paid to the 28 Class Members on October 10, 2024,  
24 was \$153,304.91, as \$11,770.91 was withheld for all applicable employee payroll taxes. The  
25 average amount of those checks was \$5,475.18.

26 9. All settlement checks were valid for 180 days from the date of issuance. The check  
27 cashing period ended on April 8, 2025.

10. As of April 30, 2025, there were 4 outstanding settlement checks totaling \$7,989.07 not cashed (the average amount of the uncashed checks was \$1,789.51), which have been cancelled. This amount constitutes unpaid cash residue or unclaimed or abandoned Class Member funds.

11. Pursuant to the terms of the Settlement Agreement and Code of Civil Procedure section 384, that the unpaid cash residue or unclaimed or abandoned Class Member funds, was transmitted to Riverside Legal Aid, Public Service Law Corporation as the cy pres recipient on April 24, 2025.

11. The Court hereby enters final judgment. Without affecting the finality of this order or the entry of judgment in any way, the Court retains jurisdiction of all matters relating to the interpretation, administration, implementation, effectuation, and enforcement of this order and the Settlement pursuant to Cal Code of Civil Procedure Section 664.6.

12. Class Counsel shall send a copy of any amended judgment which distributes funds to a cy pres recipient to the Judicial Counsel in compliance with *California Code of Civil Procedure* section 384.5. The correspondence shall include a cover letter providing the Judicial Counsel with the information required pursuant to *California Government Code* section 68520. Class Counsel shall file a Proof of Service with the Court within 15 days of the filing of the amended judgment.
