PRELIMINARY SETTLEMENT APPROVAL**

The above-entitled matter came before the Court on Plaintiffs' Motion for Preliminary Settlement Approval.

1. The Court grants preliminary approval of the settlement memorialized in the parties' Amended Settlement Agreement and Release (the "Agreement") (NYSCEF Doc. No. 9);
2. The Court finds that the proposed class preliminarily satisfies the prerequisites of New York Civil Practice Law and Rules ("CPLR") §§ 901 and 902 and provisionally certifies the class under CPLR Article 9, for settlement purposes only.
3. The Court conditionally certifies the proposed collective pursuant to 29 U.S.C. § 216(b).
4. The Court appoints Outten & Golden LLP and Shavitz Law Group, P.A as Class Counsel, for settlement purposes only.
5. The Court appoints Analytics Consulting LLC as the Settlement Administrator.
