Having reviewed and considered Plaintiff Jonathan Dardon's ("Plaintiff") Renewed Request for Dismissal, and in compliance with California Rules of Court, rule 3.770, Plaintiff's Request for Dismissal is **GRANTED**.

1. The representative PAGA claims are DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE.

4. Under California Rule of Court 3.770(c), no notice to putative class members is required.

6. Plaintiff shall serve this order on the Labor Workforce Development Agency ("LWDA") within ten (10) days of its entry.
7. The Clerk is directed to enter dismissal pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure section 581d and CLOSE the case.
