CLASS ACTION

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3 **AMENDED ORDER AND JUDGMENT**

4 1. This document shall constitute a judgment for purposes of California Rules of
5 Court, Rule 3.769(h). In accordance with, and for the reasons stated in, the Amended Order After
6 Hearing Granting Final Approval of Class Action Settlement and Request for Attorneys' Fees and
7 Costs, signed by the Court on March 17, 2025, judgment shall be entered within the meaning and
8 for purposes of Code of Civil Procedure sections 577, 904.1(a), and Rules 3.769, and 8.104 of the
9 California Rules of Court whereby the named Plaintiff/Class Representatives and all Participating
10 Class Members shall take nothing from Defendants except as expressly set forth in the Settlement
11 Agreement, which was previously filed as part of Plaintiff's Motion for Preliminary Approval of
12 Class Action Settlement and of which the Court granted final approval.

13 2. The Court, pursuant to California Rule of Court 3.769(h), shall retain jurisdiction
14 over the parties to enforce the terms of the Settlement, the Orders granting the Class Action
15 Settlement, and the Judgment.

16 3. Atticus Administration, LLC ("Settlement Administrator"), the previously-
17 approved settlement administrator for this matter, has distributed all amounts from the Gross
18 Settlement Amount as provided in the Class Action Settlement Agreement including \$7,500.00 to
19 Plaintiff Maria Guadalupe Hernandez, \$13,500 to itself, \$328,962.60 to Class Counsel for
20 attorneys' fees; \$13,571.70 to Class Counsel for litigation costs, \$26,250.00 to the Labor
21 Workforce Development Agency as 75% of the \$35,000.00 allocated to PAGA Penalties;
22 \$8,750.00 to the 485 Aggrieved Employees' as their respective shares of 25% of the \$35,000.00
23 allocated to PAGA Penalties; and the 562 Participating Class Members' respective shares of the
24 Net Settlement Amount as provided by the terms contained in the Settlement Agreement.

25 4. The check cashing period expired on October 5, 2025 (180 days from the issuance
26 date of April 8, 2025). Funds attributable to uncashed checks total \$31,838.55. Pursuant to the
27 Settlement Agreement and Code of Civil Procedure section 384, any uncashed funds are to be
28 distributed to the charity, The United Way.

1 5. Pursuant to the Settlement Agreement, \$32,869.26, or 10%, in Attorneys' Fees to
2 Class Counsel have been held by the Settlement Administrator.

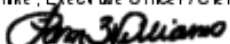
3 6. The Settlement Administrator is hereby ordered to disburse the uncashed checks
4 funds in the amount of \$31,383.55 to *cy pres* beneficiaries and Attorneys' Fees in the amount of
5 \$32,838.55 to Class Counsel. No funds shall revert to Defendant.
