Plaintiff NICHOLAS CANTALUPO's Unopposed Motion for PAGA Settlement Approval was heard in Department C-71 of the above-entitled Court on October 1, 2026, at 9:30 a.m.

Having read and considered the application filed by Plaintiff's Counsel, any opposition thereto, and the arguments of the parties, the Court finds there are sufficient grounds to grant Plaintiff's Motion. Accordingly, good cause appearing therefore,

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

The Court has reviewed and approves the terms of the parties settlement pursuant to the Private Attorneys General Act (PAGA);

- 1) The Court approves the parties proposed allocations set forth in the moving papers. Specifically, the Court approves the Gross Settlement Amount of \$30,000.00 which is broken down as follows:

*	\$11,000.00	PAGA Counsel Expenses Payment
*	\$2,198.22	Settlement Administrator Fees
*	\$16,801.78	Total PAGA Penalty. 65% shall be assigned and transmitted to the LWDA as penalties. The remaining 35% shall be allocated to the PAGA employees.

- 2) In all other respects, Judgment is entered in accordance with the terms of the parties' PAGA Settlement Agreement, which was attached to the declaration of Eric K. Yaeckel that was filed with the Court as on April 14, 2026.

- 3) The Court will retain jurisdiction over the parties to enforce the settlement until performance in full of the terms of the settlement pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure section 664.6.
