**TO THE HONORABLE COURT, ALL PARTIES, AND THEIR ATTORNEYS OF
RECORD:**

Plaintiffs Mark John Santos and Samantha Sanchez (together, “Plaintiffs”) and Defendants Medzed, LLC and Medzed Physician Services, Inc. (together, “Defendants”) (collectively, the “Parties”), by and through their respective counsel, hereby stipulate as follows:

WHEREAS, on May 10, 2022, Plaintiff Mark John Santos filed a Class Action Complaint for Damages against Defendants in the Superior Court of California for the County of Los Angeles, thereby commencing the above-captioned action (“Action”) and which alleged causes of action for: (1) failure to properly pay overtime wages under California Labor Code §§ 510 and 1198; (2) failure to provide compliant meal breaks and associated premiums under California Labor Code §§ 226.7 and 512(a); (3) failure to provide compliant rest breaks and associated premiums under California Labor Code § 226.7; (4) failure to properly pay minimum wages under California Labor Code §§ 1194, 1197, and 1197.1; (5) failure to timely pay final wages under California Labor Code §§ 201 and 202; (6) failure to timely pay wages during employment under California Labor Code § 204; (7) failure to provide accurate itemized wage statements under California Labor Code § 226(a); (8) failure to maintain requisite payroll records under California Labor Code § 1174(d); (9) failure to reimburse necessary business expenses under California Labor Code §§ 2800 and 2802; and (10) violation of California Business and Professions Code §§ 17200, *et seq.*;

WHEREAS, on December 27, 2023, Plaintiffs filed a First Amended Class Action Complaint for Damages and Enforcement Under the Private Attorneys General Act, California Labor Code § 2698, *Et Seq.*, thereby adding Samantha Sanchez as a named plaintiff and a claim for civil penalties under the Private Attorneys General Act of 2004, California Labor Code §§ 2698, *et seq.* (“PAGA”);

WHEREAS, on November 5, 2024, the Court entered the Final Approval Order and Judgment, thereby granting approval of the settlement of the Action in accordance with the Class Action and PAGA Settlement Agreement (“Settlement,” “Agreement,” or “Settlement

Agreement”), which together with the exhibits annexed thereto, set forth the terms and conditions for settlement of the Action;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Final Approval Order and Judgment, each Individual Settlement Payment and Individual PAGA Payment check shall be valid and negotiable for one hundred eighty (180) calendar days after mailing by ILYM Group, Inc. (“ILYM Group” or “Settlement Administrator”), and thereafter, shall be canceled (Final Approval Order and Judgment, ¶ 16);

WHEREAS, funds associated with such canceled checks shall be, in accordance with California Code of Civil Procedure section 384(b), transmitted to Los Angeles Bar Association’s Domestic Violence Project (Final Approval Order and Judgment, ¶ 16);

WHEREAS, on October 28, 2025, the Declaration of Cassandra Polites of ILYM Group, Inc. Regarding Disbursement of Settlement Funds (“Disbursement Declaration”) was filed with the Court;

WHEREAS, per the Disbursement Declaration, on December 20, 2024, ILYM Group issued and mailed Individual Settlement Payment checks to four hundred sixty-five (465) Participating Class Members, and Individual PAGA Payment checks to three hundred thirteen (313) Aggrieved Employees (Disbursement Declaration, ¶ 5);

WHEREAS, the check-cashing period for Settlement Class Members and Aggrieved Employees expired on June 18, 2025, which was one hundred and eighty (180) calendar days from the date the Individual Settlement Payment and Individual PAGA Payment checks were issued (Disbursement Declaration, ¶ 7);

WHEREAS, as of the date of the Disbursement Declaration, there are one hundred eight (108) checks, totaling \$55,594.27, that remain uncashed (Disbursement Declaration, ¶ 8);

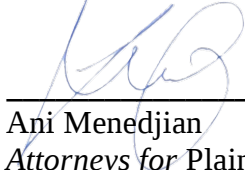
THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED, BY THE PARTIES THROUGH THEIR COUNSEL OF RECORD, THAT THE COURT SHALL ENTER AN ORDER AMENDING THE FINAL APPROVAL ORDER AND JUDGMENT AS FOLLOWS:

1. ILYM Group shall transmit \$55,594.27, representing the value of the funds associated with uncashed Individual Settlement Payment and Individual PAGA Payment checks, to Los Angeles Bar Association's Domestic Violence Project;
2. After entry of the Order approving this Stipulation, pursuant to the California Code of Civil Procedure, Plaintiffs shall submit the Order to the Judicial Council; and
3. Upon entry of the Order, the Action shall be closed.
