DECLARATION OF JOHN G. YSLAS

I, John G. Yslas, declare as follows:

1. I am an attorney at law licensed to practice before all of the courts of the State of California. I am a Senior Partner at Wilshire Law Firm, PLC (“WLF”), counsel of record for plaintiffs Jemila Hassan (individually, “Plaintiff Hassan”) and Farah Doulkidah (individually, “Plaintiff Doulkidah”). Lawyers for Justice, PC (“LFJ”) are counsel of record for plaintiff Diandrea Correa (individually, “Plaintiff Correa”) (collectively with Plaintiff Hassan and Plaintiff Doulkidah, “Plaintiffs”) I have personal knowledge of the facts set forth in this declaration and could and would competently testify to them under oath if called as a witness.

2. I submit this declaration in support of Plaintiffs’ Motion for Final Approval of Class Action and PAGA Settlement.

3. Plaintiffs are represented by WLF and LFJ. The attorneys at WLF performed significant work and expended litigation costs in prosecuting this matter with no guarantee of payment.

4. WLF was selected by Best Lawyers and U.S. News & World Report as one of the nation’s Best Law Firms since 2020 and is comprised of more than 100 attorneys and over 600 employees. WLF is actively and continuously practicing in employment litigation, representing employees in both individual and class actions in both state and federal courts throughout California.

5. WLF is qualified to handle this Litigation because its attorneys are experienced in litigating Labor Code violations in individual, class action, and representative action cases. WLF has handled, and is currently handling, numerous wage and hour class action lawsuits, as well as class actions involving consumer rights and data privacy litigation.

6. I graduated from the University of California, Santa Barbara with High Honors in 1991 with Bachelor of Arts degrees in Psychology. I received my Juris Doctor from UCLA Law School in 1996.

7. Upon graduating from law school in 1996, I worked for a boutique law firm

1 practicing general litigation which included employment law matters. Since 2000 (that is, the
2 last 25 years) my practice has been exclusively focused on labor and employment matters
3 including handling wage and hour class, collective and representative actions (including the
4 California Private Attorneys General Act, or “PAGA”), including in the international law firms
5 of Morgan, Lewis & Bockius LLP (where I was a senior associate), Foley & Lardner LLP
6 (where I was a partner and a national Vice Chair of the Labor and Employment Group), Norton
7 Rose Fulbright LLP (where I was a partner) and Seyfarth Shaw LLP (where I was a partner and
8 member of the Wage and Hour Practice Group). During my time at these law firms, I was the
9 primary attorney or took a major leading role in defending employers on numerous wage and
10 hour class, collective and representative actions.

11 8. In late June 2022 I left Seyfarth Shaw LLP and joined my current firm, Wilshire
12 Law Firm, PLC, to represent plaintiff employees. I have been and am handling many wage and
13 hour class and representative actions litigating such matters on behalf of plaintiff employees in
14 numerous Superior Courts and District Courts. From matters representing both plaintiffs and
15 defendants, I have successfully mediated the resolution of many wage and hour class,
16 collective, and representative actions. Just since starting to settle cases in late April 2023 I have
17 already successfully mediated matters in which I have been counsel or co-counsel resulting in
18 **more than \$175 million** in settlements and verdicts which are in the process of being finalized,
19 and with numerous upcoming mediations scheduled. In those and numerous other matters, I
20 have managed and assisted with the litigation and settlement of many wage and hour PAGA
21 and class actions. In those actions, I performed similar tasks as those performed in the course
22 of prosecuting this action. Indeed, I recently tried and prevailed in achieving a jury verdict in
23 a wage and hour class action in the matter of *Aguilar-Flores v. Javier’s – CC LLC*, Los Angeles
24 County Superior Court, Case No. 19STCV36438, (damages anticipated in the future and a
25 motion for attorney’s fees to be filed after that).

26 9. I have received numerous awards for my legal work. For example, from 2015 to
27 2018, I was listed in Los Angeles Super Lawyers for Employment Litigation (Thomson
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1 Reuters). I have also served on numerous prominent boards and in other leadership positions,
2 including serving as Southern California Regional President for the Hispanic National Bar
3 Association and on the board of directors of the Mexican American Bar Foundation. I also
4 previously served on the 5-member Los Angeles Civil Service Commission, which generally
5 oversees the personnel decisions for the City of Los Angeles.

6 10. I have also published numerous blogs on labor and employment issues including
7 on wage and hour issues. For example, I published “Headline News: Wal-Mart v. Dukes-
8 Impact on Class Action Litigation” (while a partner with Foley & Lardner LLP) and “Are You
9 Really Protected From Wage-and-Hour Successor Liability in an Asset Purchase” (while a
10 partner with Seyfarth Shaw LLP). I have also been a presenter at numerous conferences,
11 including being a presenter involving the “Employment Law Update” at a National
12 Employment Law Council conference. I currently bill at an hourly rate of \$1,500.00.

13 11. Samantha A. Smith was a Senior Attorney at WLF where her practice was
14 focused on managing wage and hour class action and PAGA settlements. Ms. Smith was
15 admitted to the California Bar in December of 2004, and received a J.D. from University of
16 California, Hastings College of the Law and a B.A. from University of California, Davis. Ms.
17 Smith has dedicated her 21-year career to plaintiffs’-side class action litigation. Her wealth of
18 experience includes successful work on all stages of class action litigation, including class
19 action appeals, class certification motions, and class settlements. See, e.g., *Blue Diamond*
20 *Growers Product Labeling Cases*, JCCP No. 4822 (Los Angeles County Superior Court) (false
21 advertising of Blue Diamond food products); *Adam vs. eHealth, Inc.*, Case No. 17CV309050
22 (Santa Clara County Superior Court) (employee data breach); *Overton v. Armour-Eckrich*
23 *Meats, LLC*, Case No. CIVDS1501325 (San Bernardino County Superior Court) (unpaid

11 12. Jeffrey C. Bils is an eleventh-year Senior Attorney at WLF. He graduated from
12 the University of Wisconsin–Madison with a Bachelor of Arts in Journalism and German, and
13 received his Juris Doctor from the University of California, Los Angeles School of Law in 2014.
14 During law school, he was a Senior Editor on the UCLA Law Review and an Articles Editor
15 on the Entertainment Law Review. Mr. Bils served as a Judicial Extern for the Hon. Consuelo
16 Bland Marshall in United States District Court for the Central District of California, and also
17 for the Hon. Sandra R. Klein of United States Bankruptcy Court for the Central District of
18 California. Mr. Bils graduated ranked No. 7 in his graduating class from UCLA School of Law.
19 He was admitted to practice law in the State of California in 2014. Since graduating from law
20 school, he has focused his legal work primarily on employment matters, including wage-and-
21 hour class action and PAGA representative action litigation, and he has helped obtain dozens
22 of settlements on behalf California workers, as well as on behalf of California employers during
23 his years on the defense bar. Mr. Bils is a member of the Beverly Hills Bar Association
24 (BHBA), where he is a past member of the Board of Governors and a past Chair of the Labor
25 & Employment Law Section Executive Committee. He is also a member of the California
26 Employment Lawyers Association (CELA) and the Consumer Attorneys Association of Los
27 Angeles (CAALA). Mr. Bils currently bills at an hourly rate of \$850.00.

1 13. Fawn F. Bekam was a Junior Partner at WLF. She graduated from the University
2 of California, Irvine School of Law, where she received her J.D. in 2015. She received her B.A.
3 from the University of California, Los Angeles in 2012. While in law school, she was the
4 recipient of numerous honors, including multiple Dean's Awards, Dean's Merit Scholarship,
5 and pro bono graduation honors. She has been chosen as a Super Lawyer Rising Star every
6 year since 2020 and selected for inclusion in Best Lawyers: Ones to Watch every year since
7 2021. Ms. Bekam has been appointed to class counsel in dozens of cases through both contested
8 and uncontested motions. Ms. Bekam billed at an hourly rate of \$800.00.

9 14. Diego Aviles is a Senior Attorney at Wilshire Law Firm. He graduated from the
10 University of California, Irvine, with a Bachelor of Arts in Political Science as well as a
11 Bachelor of Arts in Criminology, Law, and Society, and received his Juris Doctor from the
12 Santa Clara University School of Law in 2015. During law school, Mr. Aviles was President
13 for the Santa Clara Employment Law Society, Board Member of the Honors Moot Court, and
14 President of the Santa Clara University La Raza Chapter. He clerked for the Equal Employment
15 Opportunity Commission in San Francisco, California, and also worked with the Workers'
16 Rights Clinic in San Jose, California, among other employment law firms. He was admitted to
17 practice law in the State of California in 2017. Since graduating from law school, he has
18 focused his legal work exclusively on employment matters, including wage-and-hour class
19 action and PAGA representative action litigation, and he has helped obtain dozens of
20 settlements on behalf California workers. He has been appointed Class Counsel numerous
21 times in California and most recently achieved a published California Appellate opinion in the
22 matter of *Alberto v. Cambrian Homecare, et al.*, 91 Cal.App.5th 482 regarding employment
23 arbitration agreements. He has also been a member of the California Employment Lawyers
24 Association (CELA) since at least 2019. Mr. Aviles' currently bills at an hourly rate of \$800.00.

25 15. Aram Boyadjian is a fifth-year Associate Attorney at WLF. He was admitted to
26 practice law in the State of California in 2021. Aram graduated from the University of
27 California, Los Angeles, with a Bachelor of Arts in Political Science. He received his Juris
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1 Doctor from Loyola Law School. During law school, he was a member of the student editorial
2 board for the International and Comparative Law Review. Since January 2021, his practice has
3 mainly been focused on wage and hour class action litigation. Mr. Boyadjian currently bills at
4 an hourly rate of \$600.00.

5 16. Harry Erganyan is an Associate Attorney at Wilshire Law Firm, PLC. He was
6 admitted to practice law in the State of California in 2021. Harry graduated from Loyola
7 Marymount University, with a Bachelor of Arts in Political Science. He received his Juris
8 Doctor from Southwestern Law School. During law school, he externed for the Los Angeles
9 City Attorney. Since January 2021, Mr. Erganyan's practice has been focused on wage and hour
10 class action litigation. Mr. Erganyan currently bills at an hourly rate of \$600.00.

11 17. Lisa B. Iturriaga is a Settlement Attorney at Wilshire Law Firm, PLC. She was
12 admitted to practice law in the State of California in 2021. Ms. Iturriaga graduated from
13 University of South Florida with a Bachelor of Science in Finance and a Bachelor of Arts in
14 Marketing. She received her Juris Doctor from Chapman University Dale E. Fowler School of
15 Law. Since graduating, her practice has been in insurance defense (previously) and
16 employment law (currently). Since 2023, she has exclusively worked on Plaintiff-side wage
17 and hour cases. Ms. Iturriaga is also a member of the California Employment Lawyers
18 Association (CELA). Ms. Iturriaga currently bills at an hourly rate of \$550.00.

19 18. Andrew Sandoval is a third-year Associate Attorney at WLF. He was admitted
20 to practice law in the State of California in 2022. Andrew graduated from Azusa Pacific
21 University with a Bachelor of Arts in Economics. He received his Juris Doctor from Loyola
22 Law School. During law school, he was a Vice-President of La Raza de Loyola. Since
23 graduating, his practice has mainly been focused on wage and hour class action litigation. Mr.
24 Sandoval currently bills at an hourly rate of \$500.00.

25 19. WLF's hourly rates are comparable to those charged by other class action
26 plaintiffs' counsel and the firms defending class actions. WLF's hourly rates have been
27 approved by other courts in California in which WLF was approved as Class Counsel. *See, e.g.,*

22 expended on this action are reasonable and in line with comparable cases.

23 20. WLF has performed significant work and incurred litigation costs in prosecuting
24 this matter with no guarantee of any payment. The efforts expended by Plaintiffs' counsel to
25 achieve this result include, but are not limited to, the following:

26 a. the investigation of the matter, including meeting with Plaintiffs, reviewing
27 Defendants' policies, and requesting and reviewing Plaintiffs' time and pay records, personnel
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1 files, and exploring the corporate structure of Defendants;

2 b. filing the Actions (initial and amended complaint(s));

3 c. attending status conferences and meeting and conferring with Defendants and

4 co-counsel regarding the case;

5 d. meeting and conferring with Defendants and co-counsel regarding mediation,

6 exchange of informal discovery beforehand, and negotiating with opposing counsel regarding

7 the parameters thereof;

8 e. selecting a mediator and mediation date;

9 f. working with opposing counsel, co-counsel and expert consultants for the

10 receipt of a representative sampling and analyzing the same with the aid of expert consultants

11 and Plaintiffs to perform analyses of liability and exposure prior to attendance of the mediation

12 in this matter;

13 g. reviewing policy documents from Defendants and researching applicable

14 defenses;

15 h. preparation of the mediation brief and damages model for use at mediation;

16 i. attendance at the mediations by all Parties and Counsel;

17 j. communicating with Plaintiffs who requested updates or other information

18 regarding this matter;

19 k. negotiating, finalizing and fully executing the settlement agreement;

20 l. preparing and filing the Motion for Preliminary Approval and supporting

21 documents;

22 m. attending the hearings on Motion for Preliminary Approval;

23 n. negotiating, finalizing and fully executing amended settlement agreements;

24 o. preparing and filing supplemental Motion for Preliminary Approval and

25 supporting documents;

26 p. coordinating with the settlement administrator, and

27 q. preparing the instant Motion for Final Approval and supporting documents.

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21. WLF's current lodestar reflects the efficiencies achieved by attorneys experienced in this field with 521.8 hours of work resulting in \$467,545.00 in fees. WLF dedicated significant resources to this case by dividing the tasks required according to skill level. The hours expended by each attorney were not duplicative and reflect the extensive investigation and analysis that was required to achieve this Settlement. In total WLF and LFJ spent **838.3** hours of work resulting in **\$736,570.00** in fees (as reflected in this declaration and the declaration of Vartan Madoyan filed concurrently herewith). This amount does not include the time Class Counsel will spend at the final approval hearing and assisting the Settlement Administrator following final approval. The chart below shows the calculation of hours spent by each of WLF's attorneys on this case:

22. The risk factors present in this case favor the application of a 1.36 multiplier. To begin, Class Counsel has assumed the risk and costs of litigation purely on a contingency basis. And, while Plaintiffs are confident in the merits of their claims, a legitimate controversy exists as to each cause of action posing an actual risk that Plaintiffs may not succeed at class certification and/or trial. Any of these obstacles could have prevented recovery completely, meaning Class Counsel would have been left with no compensation for all the time and money

1 invested in litigating this case. Despite these risks, Class Counsel took this case on a
2 contingency basis so that Class Members (a particularly vulnerable group of hourly paid
3 workers) could be compensated for their unpaid wages. Consequently, Class Counsel was
4 precluded from focusing on, or taking on, other cases which could have resulted in a larger,
5 and less risky, monetary gain. This time could have been spent on other potentially lucrative
6 cases.

7 23. In litigation costs, WLF has spent \$22,330.65 on items such as filing fees,
8 service fees, mediation fees, and expert fees. Since Class Counsel's costs do not exceed the
9 maximum of \$33,000.00, the remaining \$1,523.94 will revert to the Net Settlement Amount.
10 A true and correct copies of WLF's cost reports in this matter are attached hereto as **Exhibit 1**.
11 All of the costs incurred were reasonable and necessary for the prosecution of this case.

12 24. Class Counsel has negotiated a settlement here that they believe is fair,
13 reasonable, and adequate based on their prior experience litigating these type of cases.

14 25. To date, the LWDA has not responded to or objected to the Settlement in this
15 matter.

16 I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of California that the
