

ADDENDUM TO AMENDED JOINT STIPULATION FOR CLASS ACTION SETTLEMENT AND RELEASE OF CLAIMS

This March 31, 2025 ADDENDUM supplements and amends the Amended Joint Stipulation for Class Action Settlement and Release of Claims (“Settlement Agreement”) between Plaintiff William Watson and Defendant Notarize, Inc., and is annexed to and forms part of the Settlement Agreement for all purposes. When the terms of this Addendum and the Settlement Agreement are in conflict, this Addendum shall govern and supersede the terms of the Settlement Agreement.

1. Paragraph 35(a) of the Settlement Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

“Released Claims” means the following:

a. Release as to All Participating Class Members. Effective only upon the entry of an Order granting Final Approval of the Settlement, entry of Judgment, and payment by Defendant to the Settlement Administrator of the full Gross Settlement Amount and Employers’ Taxes necessary to effectuate the Settlement, CLASS REPRESENTATIVE and all members of the Settlement Class, except those that make a valid and timely request to be excluded from the Class, waive, release, and discharge any and all claims against the Released Parties, of any of them, that were alleged in the Operative Complaint or which could have reasonably been alleged based on the facts asserted in the Operative Complaint. These claims include, but are not limited to: (1) recovery of unpaid minimum wages and liquidated damages; (2) recovery of unpaid overtime wages; (3) failure to provide meal periods of compensation in lieu thereof; (4) failure to provide rest periods or compensation in lieu thereof; (5) failure to furnish accurate itemized wage statements; (6) failure to timely pay all wages due upon separation of employment; (7) failure to reimburse business expenses; and, (8) unfair competition.. (“Class Released Claims”). As to the PAGA claims, only those Class Members who worked during the PAGA Period will release any and all claims against the Released Parties, or any of them, for civil penalties under PAGA that were alleged in the Operative Complaint or which could have reasonably been alleged based on the facts asserted in the Operative Complaint and the PAGA Notice., (“PAGA Released Claims” and, collectively with Class Released Claims, “Released Claims”).

2. The first sentence of Paragraph 35(b) of the Settlement Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

In addition to the release made in Paragraph 35(a), Plaintiff makes the additional following general release of all claims, known or unknown.

3. Paragraph 55 of the Settlement Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

Individual Settlement Payments will be calculated and distributed to Participating Class Members from the Net Settlement Amount on a *pro rata* basis, based on the Participating Class Members’ respective number of Workweeks during the Class

Period. Individual PAGA Payments to Aggrieved Employees will be calculated and distributed to Aggrieved Employees from the PAGA Payment on a *pro rata* basis based on Aggrieved Employees' respective number of Pay Periods during the PAGA Period. Specific calculations of the Individual Settlement Shares and Individual PAGA Payments to Aggrieved Employees will be made as follows:

4. The heading of Section XI of the Settlement Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

XI. DISTRIBUTION OF FUNDS

5. Exhibit A to the Settlement Agreement (the Class Notice) is replaced with Exhibit A hereto.

6. Exhibit C to the Settlement Agreement (the Objection Form) is replaced with Exhibit B hereto.

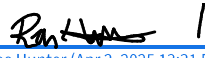
