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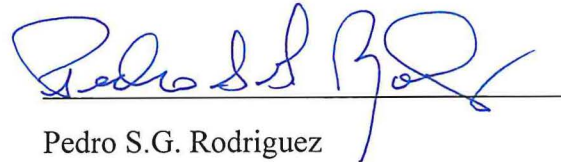
1. I am an individual over the age of 18 and hold the position of Executive Director/CEO at Coachella Valley Housing Coalition (“CVHC”). I have personal knowledge of the facts stated in this declaration and could testify competently to them if called upon to do so. This declaration is submitted for the purpose of CVHC being named as the *cy pres* recipient in the proposed class and PAGA action settlement reached in this case.

3. As requested in section G(3)(c)(iii)(A) of this Court’s Case Management Order #1, dated March 2, 2023, CVHC is a nonprofit organization. Coachella Valley Housing Coalition (CVHC) is a community development corporation serving farmworkers, their families, and other low-income residents (such as seniors, veterans, and individuals with chronic illnesses) in distressed rural and desert communities from Riverside to Imperial Counties.

5. As requested in section G(3)(c)(iii)(C) of this Court's Case Management Order #1, dated March 2, 2023, CVHC serves residents in Riverside and Imperial Counties. Since its founding in 1982, CVHC has developed more than 3,000 units of affordable rental housing including California's first affordable housing complex for retired farmworkers; helped 2124

1 families build and purchase their own single-family homes through a culturally relevant Mutual
2 Self-Help homeownership program. CVHC's major programmatic areas of work include the
3 development of both rental and homeownership housing in Riverside and Imperial Counties that
4 serve farmworkers, migrant farmworkers, veterans, very low- and low-income families, and
5 adults with special needs such as development disabilities, and/or other chronic illnesses. CVHC
6 continues to develop meaningful and needed human development programs and initiatives by
7 providing a pipeline of resident-based Community Services. Programs include early childhood
8 education programs, afterschool programs, homeownership and financial education classes,
9 computer technology classes, ESL instruction, an Alternative High School Diploma and GED
10 Program, tutoring, homework assistance, ballet folkloric dance and mariachi music instruction,
11 and a myriad of other opportunities that enrich the lives of the people living in its housing.
