1 Plaintiff Toni Andrade's unopposed Motion for Approval of California Labor Code Private
2 Attorneys General Act of 2004 ("PAGA") Settlement ("Motion") in the above-captioned action,
3 having come before the Court for a hearing on the date indicated above, and the Court being duly
4 apprised of the premises, and good cause appearing, therefore,

5 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, AJUDICATED, and DECREED THAT:

6 1. Plaintiff's Motion for Approval of California Labor Code Private Attorneys General Act of
7 2004 ("PAGA") Settlement is **GRANTED**, and the settlement of this action is hereby
8 **APPROVED**.

9 2. Capitalized terms in this Approval Order shall have the same meaning they are given in the
10 PAGA Settlement Agreement attached to the Declaration of Kaitlin Martinez as **Exhibit A**.

11 3. ILYM Group, Inc., is approved to serve as the Settlement Administrator and is hereby
12 authorized to perform all of the duties assigned to it in the Settlement Agreement and to disburse
13 the following from the Gross Settlement Amount of Thirty-Seven Thousand Three Hundred Fifty
14 Dollars (\$37,350.00) in accordance with the terms of the PAGA Settlement and Release:

15 a. A Plaintiff's Counsel Fees Payment of not more than thirty-five percent (35.00%) of the
16 Net Settlement Amount, Thirteen Thousand Seventy-Two and Fifty Cents (\$13,072.50)
17 and Plaintiff's Counsel Litigation Expenses Payment, currently Thirteen Thousand
18 Seven Hundred Forty-Two Dollars and Sixty-Six Cents (\$13,742.66) not to exceed
19 Fourteen Thousand Dollars (\$14,000.00);

20 b. Administrator Expense Payment to ILYM Group, Inc., not to exceed Three Thousand
21 Six Hundred Fifty Dollars and Zero Cents (\$3,650.00) for administration of this
22 Settlement;

23 c. To the LWDA and Aggrieved Employees for payment of the PAGA Penalties,
24 (approximately \$6,884.84), with 65% allocated to the LWDA PAGA Payment
25 (approximately \$4,475.14) and 35% (approximately \$2,409.70) allocated to the
26 Individual PAGA Payments in the form of Individual PAGA Payments, as calculated
27 pursuant to the PAGA Settlement Agreement.

1 5. Judgment shall be entered forthwith in accordance with the foregoing, with each side to pay
2 his or its own attorneys' fees and costs except as expressly set forth in the PAGA Settlement
3 Agreement;

4 6. Plaintiff shall give notice of this Judgment to the Labor and Workforce Development
5 Agency within ten (10) days after entry of the Judgment or order pursuant to California Labor Code
6 section 2699(1)(3); and

7 7. The Court retains exclusive and continuing jurisdiction over this Action for purposes of
8 supervising, administering, implementing, interpreting, and enforcing this Order and Judgment, as
9 well as the Settlement.

10 **LET JUDGMENT BE FORTHWITH ENTERED ACCORDINGLY. IT IS SO**
11 **ORDERED.**
