1 **JUDGMENT**

2 Pursuant to the Order Granting Plaintiffs Damian Lona, Abelardo Ledesma and Francisco
3 Mendoza's Motion for Final Approval of Class Action Settlement, Attorney's Fees, Costs, Service
4 Awards, and Claims Administration ("the Order Granting Final Approval of Class Action
5 Settlement"), entered on _____, it is hereby **ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND**
6 **DECREED** as follows:

7 1. Judgment in this matter is entered in accordance with the Order Granting Final
8 Approval of Class Action Settlement and the Settlement Agreement and Release (the "Settlement
9 Agreement") between Plaintiffs Damian Lona, Abelardo Ledesma and Francisco Mendoza
10 ("Plaintiffs") and Defendants Langstraat Farms, Inc., Langstraat Harvesting, Inc., Jason E.
11 Langstraat and Dennis H. Langstraat ("Defendants").

12 2. As provided by the Order Granting Final Approval of Class Action Settlement, all
13 Class Members who did not timely opt-out from the settlement are barred from pursuing any of the
14 Class Member Released Claims, as defined in the Settlement Agreement. The Settlement Class
15 consists of all persons who have been employed as non-exempt employees at Defendants' facilities
16 in California any time between March 17, 2021 to November 14, 2025, excluding all Defendants'
17 family members, office workers, and salaried employees.

18 3. Without affecting the finality of the Judgment, the Court shall retain exclusive and
19 continuing jurisdiction over the above-captioned action and the parties, including all the Class
20 Members, for purposes of enforcing the terms of the Judgment entered herein.

21 4. This document shall constitute a Judgment for purposes of California Rules of Court,
22 Rule 3.769(h).

23 5. Pursuant to California Rules of Court, Rule 3.771(b), the Claims Administrator is
24 ORDERED to post on the claims administrator's website a copy of this Judgment for a period of
25 thirty (30) days from the date the Court signs the Judgment.
