1 **[PROPOSED] ORDER AND JUDGMENT**

2 Plaintiff SHYLA THIERRY’S (“Plaintiff”) Motion to Approve the PAGA Settlement
3 Agreement (“Settlement” or “Settlement Agreement”) came regularly for hearing on
4 _____ . Appearances for the Plaintiff and Defendant BAKEMARK USA LLC
5 (“Defendant”) (Plaintiff and Defendant collectively, the “Parties”) were noted on the record.
6

7 The Court has considered the Motion, the Private Attorneys General Act Settlement
8 Agreement and Release (“Settlement Agreement” or “Settlement”) submitted herewith, all other
9 papers filed in this action, and any oral argument thereon.

10 NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED AS FOLLOWS:

11 1. Pursuant to Labor Code § 2699(l)(2), the Court approves the Settlement
12 Agreement executed by Plaintiff and Defendant and filed with this Court, which is incorporated
13 herein by this reference as though set forth in full, including the settlement administration and
14 release of claims. All defined terms contained herein shall have the same meanings as set forth
15 in the Settlement Agreement.
16

17 2. The Court finds that the Labor & Workforce Development Agency (“LWDA”)
18 has been given timely and proper notice of the Settlement Agreement pursuant to the Labor Code
19 Private Attorney General Act (“PAGA”).
20

21 3. The Parties are hereby ordered to carry out the terms of the Settlement
22 Agreement. Defendant is hereby ordered to fund the Gross Settlement Amount of \$167,000.00
23 within thirty (30) calendar days after the Court enters this Order.
24

25 4. Pursuant to the terms of the Settlement Agreement and Labor Code § 2699(i), the
26 Gross Settlement Amount of \$167,000.00 shall be distributed as follows:

- 27
- \$10,000.00 to Plaintiff for acting as the named Plaintiff;
 - \$55,666.67 to Plaintiff’s Counsel as attorneys’ fees;
- 28

- \$8,726.05 to Plaintiff's Counsel as costs;
- \$2,950.00 to Phoenix Settlement Administrators as the Settlement Administrator, who is hereby ordered to administer the Settlement;
- The remainder, or the Net PAGA Settlement Amount, after the above deductions shall be distributed 75% (\$67,242.96) to the Labor & Workforce Development Agency and 25% (\$22,414.32) to the Aggrieved Employees based on the formula set forth in the Settlement Agreement.

5. JUDGMENT IS ENTERED thereon pursuant to the terms of the Settlement Agreement. Other than as expressly provided in the Settlement Agreement, both Parties shall bear their own costs and fees.

6. Pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure § 664.6, this Court shall have and retain continuing jurisdiction over this action to enforce the terms of the Parties' Settlement Agreement.

7. Pursuant to Labor Code § 2699(1)(3), Plaintiff shall submit a copy of this Order and Judgment to the LWDA within 10 days of entry of this Order and Judgment.
