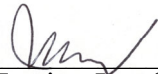

The Court confirms the tentative ruling as follows:

Plaintiff's Motion for Preliminary Approval of Class Action and PAGA Settlement

The court has reviewed and considered the papers, including the supplemental papers, filed in support of plaintiff's motion for preliminary approval of a \$60,000 class action and PAGA settlement. Subject to plaintiff's submission of the revised documents identified below, the court grants the motion as follows:

\$3,500.00 for plaintiff's enhancement payment (not to exceed);

\$18,000.00 for attorneys' fees (not to exceed);

\$4,000.00 for litigation costs (not to exceed);

\$6,000.00 for settlement administration costs (not to exceed); and

\$5,000.00 total PAGA penalties (\$3,750.00 to LWDA).

The court has the following comments:

1. In its May 23, 2024 order (ROA 61, No. 13), the court stated that class members are not required to notify the court of their intent to appear at the final approval hearing. The phrase "provided you notify the Court of your intent to do so" should be removed from the notice. Jusuf Decl. (ROA 76) Ex. 4 (§ F at page 5)

2. Regarding the proposed order (ROA 65):

- a. At page 1 line 11, "Exhibit A" should state "Exhibit 2";
- b. At page 2 lines 13, 15 and 16, the words "up to" should be inserted before "\$6,000.00," "\$3,500.00" and "\$18,000.00";
- c. At page 3 line 26, "2024" should state "2025"; and
- d. At page 4 line 7, "retain" should state "retains."

Plaintiff is ordered to file and serve by October 24, 2024 (i) a revised class notice (see Item No. 1 above); and (ii) a revised proposed order with all exhibits attached (including the revised class notice, see Item Nos. 1 and 2 above).

The final approval hearing is scheduled for March 13, 2025 at 2:00 p.m. in Department CX104. The motion for final approval shall be filed at least 16 court days before the hearing. See Department CX104 Guidelines for Approval of Class Action Settlements and PAGA Settlements (www.occourts.org).

Plaintiff is ordered to give notice, including to the LWDA, and to file a proof of service.

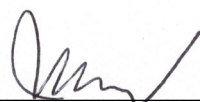
