2 The Motion of plaintiff Cameron Crary (“Plaintiff”) for approval of attorney’s fees;
3 reimbursement of litigation costs; and administrative and service payments came on regularly for
4 hearing on November 7, 2025. John Claassen, Esq. appeared for Plaintiff. [_____] [Joe Rose]

6 The Court has reviewed Plaintiff’s moving papers including the Notice of Motion and Motion,
7 the Memorandum of Points and Authorities, and the Declarations of John Claassen and Cameron
8 Crary, as well as other pleadings on file in this Action. It has also considered papers filed if any in
9 opposition to Plaintiff’s Motion. The Court has also taken into consideration argument of counsel and

11 After such review and consideration, for good cause shown, the Court hereby GRANTS
12 Plaintiff’s Motion in its entirety as follows: the following is approved and ordered as payment from the
13 gross settlement amount as follows:

- 14 1. An award for attorney’s fees in the amount of \$9,000 to Plaintiff’s Counsel.
- 15 2. An award in the amount of \$5,000 to Plaintiff’s counsel for the reimbursement of
16 litigation costs.
- 17 3. A service payment award to plaintiff Cameron Crary in the amount of \$6,000.
- 18 4. A payment not to exceed \$5,000, for administrative fees to Phoenix Class Action
19 Administration Solutions.
- 20 5. All such payments shall be paid from the Gross Settlement Amount in the time and
21 manner provided for in the Parties’ PAGA Settlement Agreement.
