**~~PROPOSED~~ ORDER GRANTING MOTION
FOR APPROVAL OF PAGA SETTLEMENT
AND ENTERING JUDGMENT**

1 The Court has received and considered the joint stipulation of Plaintiff Kelley L. Stover, as
2 an individual, and on behalf of the people of the State of California and as an “aggrieved employee”
3 acting as a private attorney general under the Labor Code Private Attorneys General Act of 2004,
4 § 2699, *et seq.* (“PAGA”) and Defendant Decron Properties Corp. in the above-captioned action.

5 **NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED:**

6 The Judgment incorporates by reference the definitions in the PAGA Settlement and
7 Release Agreement (the “Settlement”), a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 to the Declaration
8 of Jessica L. Campbell in Support of Motion for Approval of Private Attorneys General Act
9 Representative Action Settlement, and all terms defined therein shall have the same meaning as set
10 forth in the Settlement.

11 The Court hereby approves the Parties’ proposed Settlement and hereby enters FINAL
12 JUDGMENT based on the terms set forth in the Parties’ Settlement in favor of Plaintiff and the
13 Aggrieved Employees in the Gross Settlement Amount of \$350,000.00. Of this, up to one-third of
14 the Gross Settlement Amount (meaning \$116,666.67) is awarded as attorney fees paid to Plaintiff’s
15 Counsel, \$16,655.55 is awarded as costs paid to Plaintiff’s Counsel, \$10,000.00 is awarded to
16 Plaintiff in exchange for a General Release, and \$4,700.00 is awarded as administrative costs paid
17 to the Settlement Administrator. Of the remaining Net Settlement Amount (\$201,977.78), 75%
18 (which is \$151,483.34) shall be paid to the Labor and Workforce Development Agency and 25%
19 (which is \$50,494.45) shall be paid to the Aggrieved Employees as set forth in the Settlement.

20 The Court hereby approves, as to form and content, the notice to be distributed to the PAGA
21 Employees, attached to the Settlement as Exhibit A. All Individual Settlement Checks will expire
22 180 days after the initial mailing. Any uncashed funds shall be transmitted to the State Controller’s
23 Office Unclaimed Property Fund in the name of each Aggrieved Employee whose check is voided.

24 A Final Compliance Hearing is set for **May 5, 2026 at 8:30 a.m.** before this Court. The
25 administrator is to file a declaration no later than 5 court days in advance to confirm that the
26 distribution of funds is complete, including any distribution to the State Controller per the
27 settlement agreement.

1 This Judgment is intended to be a final disposition in its entirety of the above captioned
2 action. Without affecting the finality of this judgment in any way, the Court retains jurisdiction of
3 all matters relating to the interpretation, administration, implementation, effectuation, and
4 enforcement of the Settlement pursuant to C.C.P. § 664.6.

5 IT IS SO ORDERED.
