Thank you for confirming that the Labor and Workforce Development Agency can correct the clerical error in the above-referenced filing. I write to detail the error and to formally request the correction pursuant to your instruction.

I. Description of the Error

When I completed the LWDA online filing form for the Initial PAGA Notice in this matter on January 25, 2026, I inadvertently entered “*Dispatcher*” in the “Employer” field. “Dispatcher” is the job position held by Plaintiff Miguel Montano Ramirez during his employment. It is not the name of the employer. The form should have listed the name(s) of the actual employer entit(ies) identified in the PAGA Notice itself.

II. Requested Correction

I respectfully request that the Agency amend the “Employer” field in the filing record for LWDA Case No. LWDA-CM-1152378-26 to reflect the correct employer names as set forth in the PAGA Notice served on the defendants:

- 1. Dodson Valco, Inc.**
- 2. Texas Pipe and Supply Company**

Both entities share the same address of record: 2330 Holmes Road, Houston, TX 77051.

III. The PAGA Notice as Served Correctly Identifies the Employers

The error was limited to the data entered into the LWDA online form. The actual PAGA Notice that was timely served on the defendants by certified U.S. mail on January 25, 2026 correctly identifies both Dodson Valco, Inc. and Texas Pipe and Supply Company as the addressees and as the named “Defendants.” A true and correct copy of the served PAGA Notice is attached hereto for the Agency’s reference. Because the defendants were properly named and served, no amended Notice to the employers is warranted—only the Agency’s internal form data needs to be corrected.

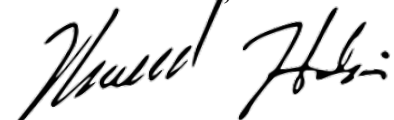
IV. Conclusion
