

1 e) \$25,000 for PAGA allocation

2 f) \$337,500 is the remaining net settlement amount

3 5. The Court finds the service award of \$7,500 to Jason Johnson is fair and reasonable
4 in light of service to the class members.

5 6. The Court finds that Class Counsel's request for attorney fees of \$200,000 (one-third
6 of the gross settlement amount) is fair and reasonable considering the results achieved, the
7 contingent risk undertaken, and the prevailing market rates for similarly qualified counsel.

8 7. The requested costs up to \$15,000 is also reasonable and were necessarily incurred.

9 8. The Court approves CPT Group's expenses of \$15,000.

10 9. The Court finds the PAGA allocation of \$25,000 is fair and reasonable.

11 10. The Court orders distribution of the settlement proceeds in accordance with the
12 terms of the settlement agreement.

13 11. Upon the effective date, the class members are deemed to have released the Released
14 Claims defined in the Settlement Agreement.

15 12. The Court will retain jurisdiction to enforce the settlement pursuant to Code of Civil
16 Procedure section 664.6 and Rule of Court 3.769(h).

17 13. The parties shall comply with the deadlines in the Settlement Agreement with
18 respect to funding and distribution.

19 14. A final compliance hearing is set for 07/16/2027 at 4 PM as a Non-Appearance Case Review.

20 Class Counsel and/or the Settlement Administrator shall file a declaration regarding
21 compliance at least ^{2 court days} ~~a week~~ before the hearing.
