6 eighty (180) calendar days from the date the checks were issued.

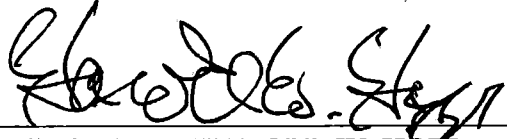
7 Pursuant to the Settlement Agreement, the Settlement Administrator will pay the
