2 YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED THAT at 9:00 a.m. on October 17, 2025 in
3 Department 23 at the above entitled Court before the Honorable Jill H. Talley, Plaintiff
4 Tikia Hopkins (“Plaintiff”) will apply for an order: (1) preliminarily approving the proposed
5 settlement of this class action with Defendant Child Action, Inc. (“Defendant”); (2) for
6 settlement purposes only, conditionally certifying the Class, which is comprised of “all
7 individuals who are or previously were employed by Defendant Child Action, Inc. who were
8 classified as non-exempt in the State of California during the Class Period”, which is
9 February 13, 2020 through April 14, 2025; (3) provisionally appointing Plaintiff as the
10 representative of the Class; (4) provisionally appointing Blumenthal Nordrehaug Bhowmik
11 De Blouw LLP as Class Counsel; (5) approving the form and method for providing class-
