**REVISED [PROPOSED] FINAL
JUDGMENT**

REVISED [PROPOSED] FINAL JUDGMENT

1 The Court, having received and considered the Private Attorneys General Act ("PAGA")
2 Settlement Agreement ("Settlement") of Plaintiff Sara Steele-Ramirez ("Plaintiff") and Defendants
3 Project Partners Inc. and PrideStaff dba PrideStaff, Inc. ("Defendants"), approved by this court on
4 May 29, 2026, has entered the Order for approval of the Settlement between Plaintiff on behalf of
5 herself and all other similarly situated employees, and Defendants.
6

7 There are approximately 147 Aggrieved Employees, defined as a person employed by
8 Defendant Project Partners in California and classified as an hourly, non-exempt employee who
9 worked for Defendant Project Partners during the PAGA Period from November 15, 2022 to August
10 10, 2025 and also including all temporary placements employed by Defendant PrideStaff as hourly,
11 non-exempt employs on assignment through or with Defendant Project Partners at any time during
12 the PAGA period.

14 The Court has finally approved the allocations of funds from the Gross Settlement Amount,
15 and has found the Settlement to be fair, reasonable, and adequate.
16

17 **NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED:**

18 The Court having entered an Order Granting Approval of the PAGA Settlement filed in this
19 Action hereby enters FINAL JUDGMENT in favor of Plaintiff and the Aggrieved Employees in the
20 amount of One Hundred Eighteen Thousand Six Hundred and Fifty Dollars and Zero Cents
21 (\$118,650.00).

23 Without affecting the finality of this Judgment, pursuant to California Code of Civil
24 Procedures section 664.6 the Court shall retain continuing jurisdiction over this action and the
25 parties, including all Aggrieved Employees and over all matters pertaining to the implementation
26 and enforcement of the terms of the Settlement. Except as provided to the contrary herein, any
27 disputes or controversies arising with respect to interpretation, enforcement or implementation of the
28 Settlement shall be presented by motion to the Court for resolution.

This Judgment is intended to be a final disposition of the above-captioned action in its

entirety and is intended to be immediately appealable. Subject to the Court's continuing jurisdiction as set forth above, the Court directs the Clerk of the Court to enter Judgment.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
