2 **TO ALL PARTIES AND THEIR ATTORNEYS OF RECORD:**

3 On February 9, 2026, the Court entered an Order which granted Plaintiff's Motion for
4 Preliminary Approval of Class Action and PAGA Settlement, granted conditional class certification,
5 approved the format of the Class Notice, and set a Final Approval Hearing (the "Preliminary
6 Approval Order"), thereby preliminarily approving a settlement of the above-entitled action (the
7 "Action") that was reached between Plaintiff Pricilla C. Tejeda ("Plaintiff") and Defendants The
8 Sisters of Nazareth Foundation, Inc., and The Sisters of Nazareth of Los Angeles ("Defendant Group
9 1"), and Defendants Nazareth House of Los Angeles, Inc., The Congregation of the Sisters of
10 Nazareth USA, Inc., Nazareth House of Fresno, Inc., Nazareth House of San Rafael, Inc., Nazareth
11 House of San Diego, Inc., and Nazareth School of San Diego, Inc. ("Defendant Group 2")
12 (collectively, "Defendants") (together with Plaintiff, the "Parties"), in accordance with the Class
13 Action and PAGA Settlement Agreement and Class Notice (the "Settlement"). The Settlement is
14 attached as **Exhibit 1** to the Declaration of Kane Moon in Support of Plaintiff's Motion for Final
15 Approval of Class Action and PAGA Settlement.

16 The Court has entered an Order granting final approval of the Parties' Settlement (the "Final
17 Approval Order"). The Court now has before it a [Proposed] Judgment.

18 The Court, having entered a Final Approval Order in this Action, and good cause appearing,

19 **HEREBY ADJUDGES AND DECREES AS FOLLOWS:**

20 1. The Court, for purposes of this Judgment, refers to all terms and definitions as set
21 forth in the Settlement.

22 2. The Court enters Judgment as follows: Plaintiff, Class Counsel, Aggrieved
23 Employees, the California Labor and Workforce Development Agency, and the Administrator shall
24 take nothing from Defendants except as expressly set forth in the Final Approval Order and according
25 to the terms of the Settlement.

26 3. The Parties shall bear their own respective attorneys' fees and costs, except as
27 otherwise provided for in the Settlement and approved by the Court.

28 4. This Judgment and the concurrently filed Final Approval Order are intended to be a

1 final disposition of the Action in its entirety and are intended to be immediately appealable.

2 5. Notwithstanding the finality of this Judgment, pursuant to California Rules of Court
3 Rule 3.769, *et seq.* and California Code of Civil Procedure section 664.6, the Court shall retain
4 jurisdiction over the Parties, Action, and the Settlement solely for purposes of (i) enforcing the
5 Settlement and/or Judgment, (ii) addressing settlement administration matters, and (iii) addressing
6 such post-Judgment matters as are permitted by law.

7 **IT IS SO ADJUDGED.**
