1 **TO ALL PARTIES AND THEIR COUNSEL OF RECORD:**

2 Plaintiff KARINA HUIZAR RODRIGUEZ (“Plaintiff”) and Defendant TFC
3 MANUFACTURING INC. (“Defendant”) reached terms of settlement for a putative class and PAGA
4 representative action. On or about October 22, 2025, the Court issued an Order granting Plaintiff’s
5 motion for final approval of a proposed class and PAGA representative action settlement of the claims
6 asserted against Defendant in this action (“Final Approval Order”). The settlement is memorialized in
7 the CLASS ACTION AND PAGA REPRESENTATIVE ACTION SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT (*see*
8 Declaration of Lilit Tunyan In Support of Plaintiff’s Motion for Final Approval of Class and PAGA
9 Representative Action Settlement [Tunyan Decl.], at Exh. 1) which is referred to herein as the
10 “Settlement” or “Settlement Agreement”.

11 The Court’s Final Approval Order is incorporated herein in its entirety. The Court now enters
12 Judgment following the entry of the Final Approval Order. The Judgment set forth herein is intended to
13 be a final disposition of the Action in its entirety and is intended to be immediately appealable.

14 **JUDGMENT**

15 In accordance with and for the reasons stated in the Final Approval Order, Judgment shall be
16 entered whereby the Plaintiff, all Settlement Class Members, and all PAGA Employees shall take
17 nothing from Defendant, except as expressly set forth in the Final Approval Order and the Settlement.

18 The Class Members are:

19 All persons who worked for Defendant in California as an hourly paid, non-exempt
20 employee and who did not sign individual settlement and release agreements with
21 Defendant during the Class Period (the “Class Period” is January 30, 2020 through
October 25, 2024.)

22 There were no objections and requests for exclusion submitted by Class Members.

23 The Court also defines the following “PAGA Employees” impacted by the proposed settlement
24 of PAGA claims:

25 All persons who worked for Defendant in California as an hourly paid, non-exempt
26 employee and did not sign individual settlement and release agreements with Defendant
27 during the PAGA Period. (the “PAGA Period” is January 30, 2023 through October
25, 2024.)

28 Class and PAGA Representative Action claims are released, pursuant to the terms of the

Settlement, as follows:

Effective on the date when Defendant fully funds the entire Gross Settlement Amount and fund all employer payroll taxes owed on the Wage Portion of the Individual Class Payments, Plaintiff, Class Members who have not submitted a valid and timely Request for Exclusion as to claims other than the PAGA claim, and Class Counsel will release claims against all Released Parties as follows:

Release by Participating Class Members Who Are Not Aggrieved Employees: All Participating Class Members, on behalf of themselves and their respective former and present representatives, agents, attorneys, heirs, administrators, successors, and assigns, release Released Parties from all claims that were alleged, or reasonably could have been alleged, based on the Class Period facts stated in the Operative Complaint. Except as set forth in Section 5.3 of this Agreement, Participating Class Members do not release any other claims, including claims for vested benefits, wrongful termination, violation of the Fair Employment and Housing Act, unemployment insurance, disability, social security, workers' compensation, or claims based on facts occurring outside the Class Period.

Release by Non-Participating Class Members Who Are Aggrieved Employees: All Non-Participating Class Members who are Aggrieved Employees are deemed to release, on behalf of themselves and their respective former and present representatives, agents, attorneys, heirs, administrators, successors, and assigns, the Released Parties from all claims for PAGA penalties that were alleged, or reasonably could have been alleged, based on the PAGA Period facts stated in the Operative Complaint and the PAGA Notice letter.

"Released Parties" means: Defendant and each of its former and present directors, officers, shareholders, owners, agents, employees, attorneys, insurers, predecessors, successors, assigns.

Distributions pursuant to the Settlement shall issue in the amounts authorized in the Final Approval Order, according to the deadlines specified in the Settlement.

Pursuant to California Code of Civil Procedure Section 664.6 and Rule 3.769(h) of the California Rules of Court, this Court reserves exclusive and continuing jurisdiction over this action, the Plaintiff, Settlement Class Members, and Defendant, for the purposes of:

- (a) supervising the implementation, enforcement, construction, and interpretation of the Settlement, the Preliminary Approval Order, the plan of allocation, the Final Approval Order, and the Judgment; and
- (b) supervising distribution of amounts paid under this Settlement.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
