1 The Court has reviewed the Stipulation for Approval of PAGA Settlement and the PAGA
2 Settlement Agreement submitted by the parties in *Choi v. Agassi Gopchang, LLC, et al.*, and finds and
3 orders as follows:

4 1. Judgment in the *Choi* action is entered in accordance with the Parties' PAGA Settlement
5 Agreement attached as Exhibit A to the Stipulation for Approval of PAGA Settlement. Unless otherwise
6 provided herein, all capitalized terms used herein shall have the same meaning as defined in the PAGA
7 Settlement Agreement.

8 2. The Court finds that it has jurisdiction over the subject matter of the *Choi* action and over
9 all parties to the *Choi* action, including all Aggrieved Employees, defined as all former and current
10 employees of Defendants in the State of California who were paid on a non-exempt basis during the
11 PAGA Period of January 2, 2023 through June 29, 2025.

12 3. All Aggrieved Employees have released and forever discharged, on behalf of themselves
13 and their respective former and present representatives, agents, attorneys, heirs, administrators,
14 successors and assigns, the Released Parties from all claims for PAGA penalties that were alleged, or
15 reasonably could have been alleged, based on the PAGA Period facts stated in the Operative Complaint,
16 the PAGA Notice, and the Amended PAGA Notice.

17 4. The Court approves the Gross Settlement Amount of \$290,000.00.

18 5. PAGA Counsel, Law Office of Jonathan Ricasa and Briana Kim, PC, are awarded
19 attorneys' fees in the amount of \$96,666.67 and litigation costs in the amount of \$13,062.66.

20 6. Plaintiff Soo In Choi is awarded a PAGA Plaintiff Service Payment in the amount of
21 \$10,000.00.

22 7. The Administrator, Phoenix Settlement Administrators, is awarded an Administrator
23 Expenses Payment in the amount of \$8,500.00.

24 8. Payment of \$105,150.94 (65% of \$161,770.67 amount of consideration that will be
25 subject to the 65%/35% allocation) to the California Labor and Workforce Development Agency
26 ("LWDA PAGA Payment") is approved.

27 9. Payment of \$56,619.73 (35% of \$161,770.67 amount of consideration that will be subject
28 to the 65%/35% allocation) to the Aggrieved Employees ("Individual PAGA Payment") is approved and

1 shall be distributed on a pro rata basis pursuant to the PAGA Settlement Agreement.

2 10. Within thirty (30) calendar days after the Court grants approval of the settlement,
3 Defendants shall fund the Gross Settlement Amount by transmitting the funds to the Administrator in
4 accordance with the PAGA Settlement Agreement.

5 11. Within fourteen (14) calendar days after Defendants fund the Gross Settlement Amount,
6 the Administrator shall distribute the Individual PAGA Payments, the LWDA PAGA Payment, the
7 approved attorneys' fees and litigation costs, the settlement administration costs, and the PAGA Plaintiff
8 Service Payment in accordance with the PAGA Settlement Agreement.

9 12. Aggrieved Employees shall have one hundred eighty (180) days from the date of mailing
10 to cash their settlement checks. For any checks remaining uncashed after the void date, the
11 Administrator shall transmit the funds represented by such checks to the Legal Aid at Work, the Cy Pres
12 Recipient, a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization.

13 13. Notice of Judgment in the *Choi* action shall be posted on the Administrator's website.

14 14. Without affecting the finality of this Judgment, the Court retains continuing jurisdiction
15 over the parties in the *Choi* action and the administration and enforcement of the PAGA Settlement
16 Agreement and this Judgment.

17 15. Plaintiff shall provide notice of this Order and Judgment, including notice to the LWDA,
18 and shall file proof of service within five (5) calendar days after entry of this Order and Judgment.
