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DECLARATION OF SUSAN J. PEREZ

I, Susan J. Perez declare as follows:

1. I am an associate with Haines Law Group, APC, and counsel for the named Plaintiffs Miranda Maravilla, Betsy Castellanos, and Sara Moreno (collectively, “Plaintiffs”) in the above-captioned matter. I am a member in good standing of the bar of the State of California and am admitted to practice in this Court. I have personal knowledge of the facts stated in this declaration and could testify competently to them if called upon to do so.

2. I received a Bachelor of Arts degree from UCSD in 2012, and a Juris Doctor from Loyola Law School, Los Angeles, in 2019. I was admitted to the California State Bar in December 2019. During law school, I externed for an administrative law judge at the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission in Los Angeles, California, where I assisted with drafting decisions on motions for summary judgment and attorneys’ fees petitions. I also externed for a federal bankruptcy judge, where I drafted bench memoranda on substantive bankruptcy and civil procedure issues.

3. From December 2019 to May 2021, I was an associate attorney at B&D Law Group, APLC, a law firm dedicated to the practice of Plaintiff-side personal injury law located in Los Angeles, California. From June 2021 to December 2022, I was an associate attorney at Lucas and Barba, LLP, where I focused primarily on removal defense in U.S. immigration courts. Since January 2022, I have worked as an associate at Haines Law Group, APC.
