5 as reflected in the Parties' joint PAGA Settlement Agreement ("Agreement"), hereby enters
6 FINAL JUDGMENT in favor of Plaintiff and the Settlement Class in the amount of \$100,000.00.
7 This Judgment is intended to be a final disposition of the above captioned action in its entirety,
8 and is intended to be immediately appealable.

9 This Judgment covers and bars other PAGA claims that have been asserted, or reasonably
10 could be asserted, by other representative Plaintiff(s) based on the facts stated in the Operative
11 Complaint and the PAGA Notice and/or ascertained in the course of the Action including, but not
12 limited to, any claims for civil penalties based on Defendant's alleged: (a) failure to pay minimum,
13 straight time, and overtime wages; (b) failure to provide legally compliant meal periods or pay
14 meal period premiums; (c) failure to authorize and permit rest periods or pay rest period premiums;
15 (d) failure to pay all earned wages twice per month; (e) failure to maintain accurate records of
16 hours worked and meal periods; (f) failure to pay all commissions owed; (g) failure to timely pay
17 final wages at termination; (h) failure to furnish accurate wage statements, and (i) failure to
18 reimburse or indemnify all necessary business expenses.

20 The Court retains jurisdiction over the parties to enforce the terms of the judgment.

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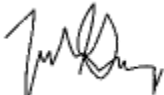
