1 **JUDGMENT**

2 Pursuant to the Order Approving Representative Action Settlement, it is hereby
3 **ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED** as follows:

4 1. Judgment in this matter is entered in accordance with the Court's Order Approving
5 Representative Action Settlement and the Parties' Joint Stipulation Re: PAGA Settlement
6 ("Settlement," "Agreement" or "Settlement Agreement"). Unless otherwise provided herein, all
7 capitalized terms used herein shall have the same meaning as defined in the Settlement Agreement.

8 2. The "Aggrieved Employees" who are covered by the Settlement Agreement are all
9 persons currently or formerly employed by defendant Damn Fine Pizza, LLC ("Defendant"), as non-
10 exempt, hourly-paid employees, during the period from May 8, 2023 through October 16, 2025
11 ("PAGA Period") in the State of California (or if any such person is incompetent, deceased, or
12 unavailable due to military service, the person's legal representative or successor in interest
13 evidenced by reasonable verification).

14 3. Pursuant to the Order Approving Representative Action Settlement, Defendant must
15 fund the settlement account with the Gross Settlement Amount, which, unless escalated pursuant to
16 the Settlement Agreement, amounts to \$500,000.00. All funds shall be disbursed to Plaintiffs,
17 PAGA Counsel, the California Labor and Workforce Development Agency ("LWDA"), the
18 Settlement Administrator, and Aggrieved Employees pursuant to the Order Approving
19 Representative Action Settlement. The funds associated with uncashed expired checks shall be
20 transmitted to the California State Controller's Office, Unclaimed Property Division in the name of
21 the Aggrieved Employee.

22 4. Upon full funding of the Settlement, the State of California, and all Aggrieved
23 Employees are deemed to release, on behalf of themselves and their respective former and present
24 representatives, agents, attorneys, heirs, administrators, successors, and assigns, Released Parties
25 from all claims, rights, demands, liabilities and causes of action that arose during the PAGA Period
26 for civil penalties under PAGA that were alleged, or reasonably could have been alleged, based on
27 the facts stated in the Operative Complaint, the Ewing PAGA Notice, and/or the Hudson PAGA
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1 Notice for PAGA civil penalties, including, but not limited to, Labor Code sections 201.3, 210, 213,
2 225.5, 226.3, 226.6, 558, 558.1, 1174.5, 1197.1 and 2699, in connection with alleged violations of
3 Labor Code sections 98.6, 201, 201.3, 202, 203, 223, 204, 216 226, 226.3, 226.7, 227.3, 232, 232.5,
4 233, 234, 246, *et seq.*, 248.2, 432, 432.5, 432.7, 510, 512, 558, 1024.5, 1102.5, 1174, 1194, 1194.2,
5 1197, 1197.1, 1198, 1198.5, 1199, 1527, 2699, 2802, 2810.5, 3366, 3457, 6401, 6402, 6403, 8397.4
6 among others.
