1 I, Lorelei Ansis, hereby declare as follows:

2 1. I have personal knowledge of the facts set forth herein and if called upon to testify,
3 I could and would do so competently under oath. I make this declaration in support of my Motion
4 for Preliminary Approval of Class Action and PAGA Settlement.

5 2. I worked for Aloha Residential Care Facility Inc. and Arleen's Residential Care,
6 Inc. ("Aloha") as an hourly-paid, non-exempt caregiver from around 2018 to around November
7 2023.

8 3. Based on my experience and knowledge of Aloha's wage and hour policies and my
9 familiarity with its employment practices, I worked with my attorneys to bring claims on my own
10 behalf as well as on behalf of other hourly-paid, non-exempt employees of Aloha.

11 4. I am seeking to become a class representative in this case. I believe my experiences
12 are similar to other hourly-paid, non-exempt employees of Aloha. I believe we were all subject to
13 the same employment policies and practices.

14 5. I do not have any conflicts with other hourly-paid, non-exempt employees that
15 would interfere with my ability to represent them. I believe I will adequately represent the other
16 hourly-paid, non-exempt employees at Aloha.

17 6. My interests as a named plaintiff in this case are not adverse to the interests of the
18 other hourly-paid, non-exempt employees. I believe my interests are the same as the other
19 employees because we were all subject to the same policies and practices and were similarly
20 injured by Aloha's company-wide policies and practices. I am seeking the same recovery on behalf
21 of myself and the other employees, which is to collect unpaid wages, penalties, and interest that
22 are owed to us by Aloha.

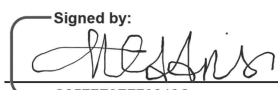
23 7. I have always kept the best interests of the other hourly-paid, non-exempt employees
