Having considered the Declaration of William M. Pao in Support of Plaintiffs' Request for Dismissal of Individual and Representative PAGA Claims against Defendant ATRIA MANAGEMENT COMPANY, LLC ("Defendant") without prejudice, the facts upon which the Declaration is based, and good cause appearing, it is hereby ORDERED as follows:

- (1) Pursuant to California Rules of Court, Rule 3.770(b), no hearing regarding Plaintiffs' Request for Dismissal of Individual and Representative PAGA Claims Without Prejudice is required;
- (2) Plaintiffs' Individual PAGA Claims are dismissed without prejudice;
- (3) Plaintiffs' Representative PAGA Claims are dismissed without prejudice;
- (4) Pursuant to California Rules of Court, Rule 3.770(c), Plaintiffs are not required to provide notice of this dismissal to aggrieved employees because the rights of aggrieved employees are not prejudiced by this dismissal.
